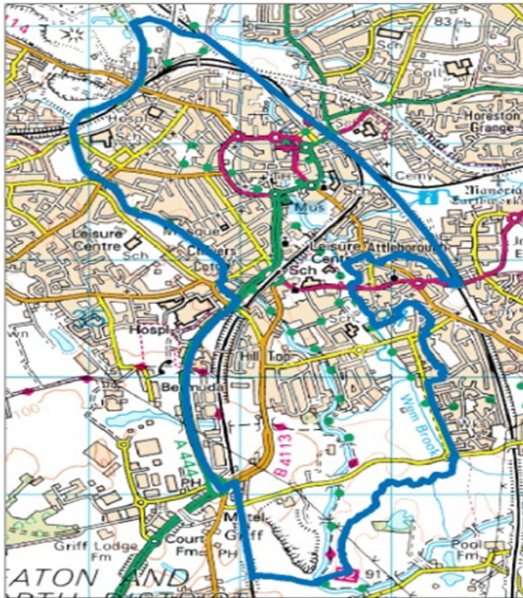


Abbey & Wem Brook



The locality of Abbey and Wem Brook comprises the wards of Wem Brook, Abbey and a small northern section of Attleborough. It also includes the County Council Electoral Divisions of Nuneaton Abbey and Nuneaton Wem Brook.

The locality covers the central core of Nuneaton & Bedworth Borough in an area measuring approximately 2 square miles. It includes the main retail shopping part of Nuneaton town centre and a range of residential housing

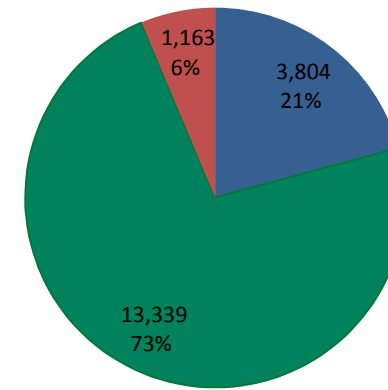

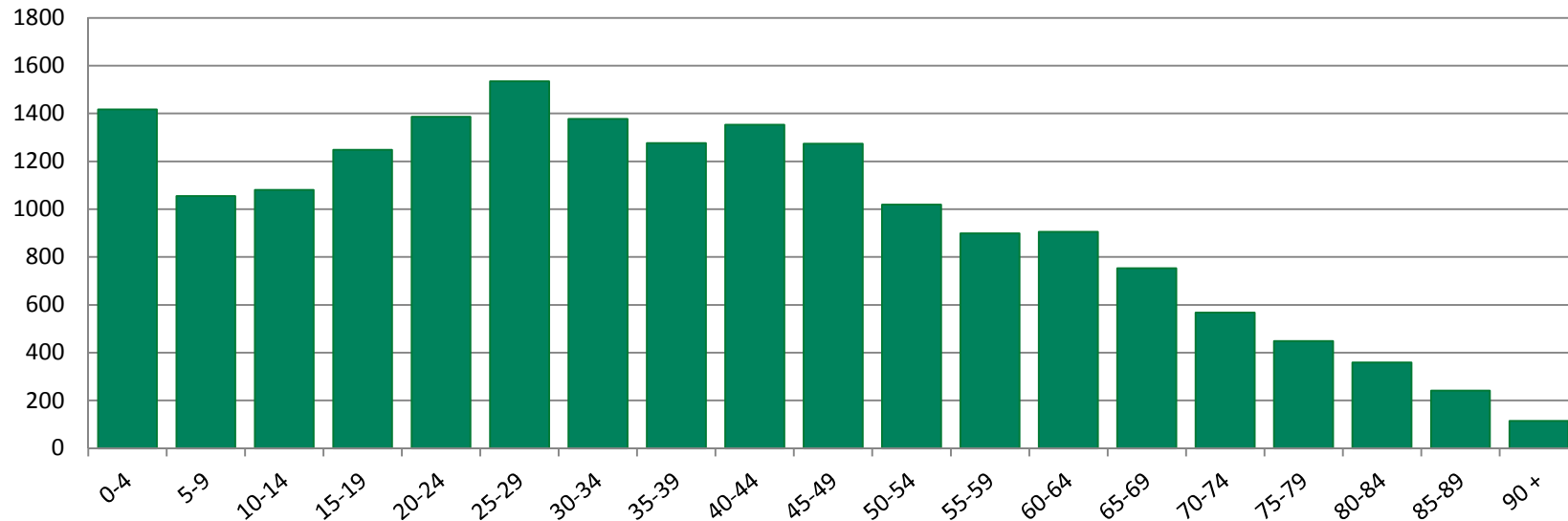

Population By Five Year Age Groups

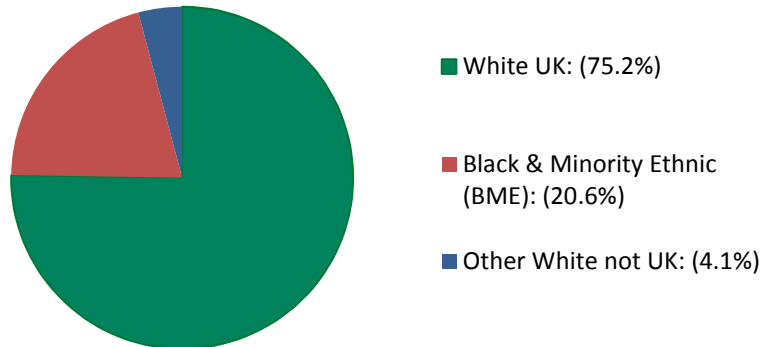

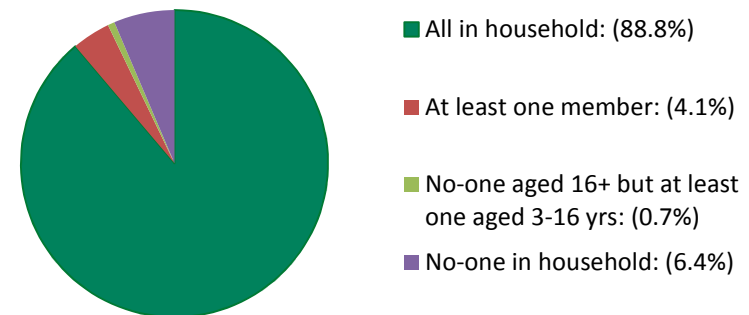

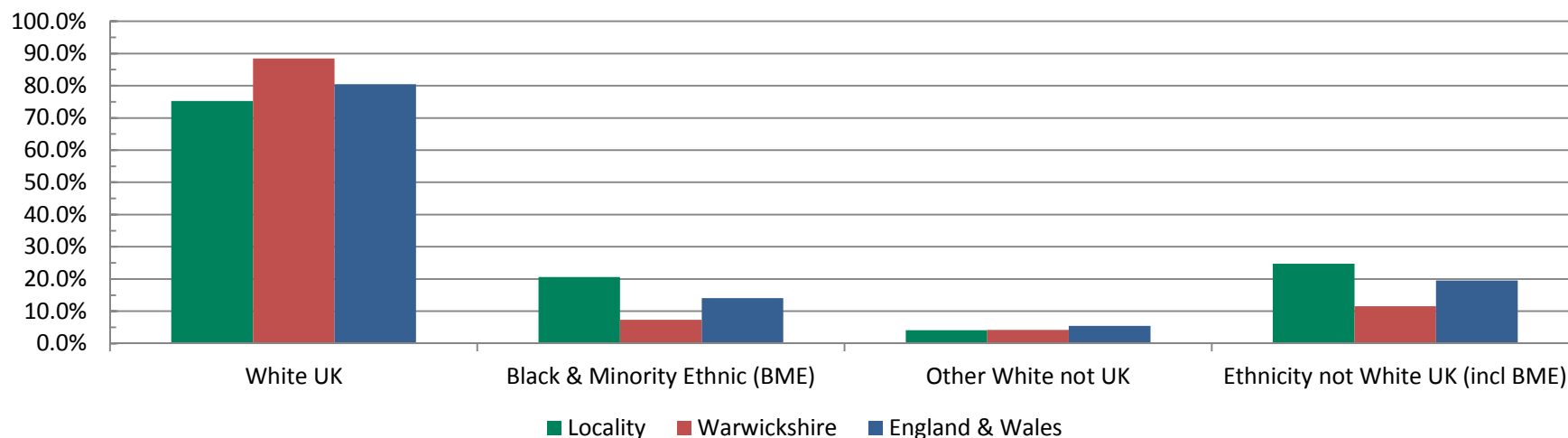
Composition of Locality Population

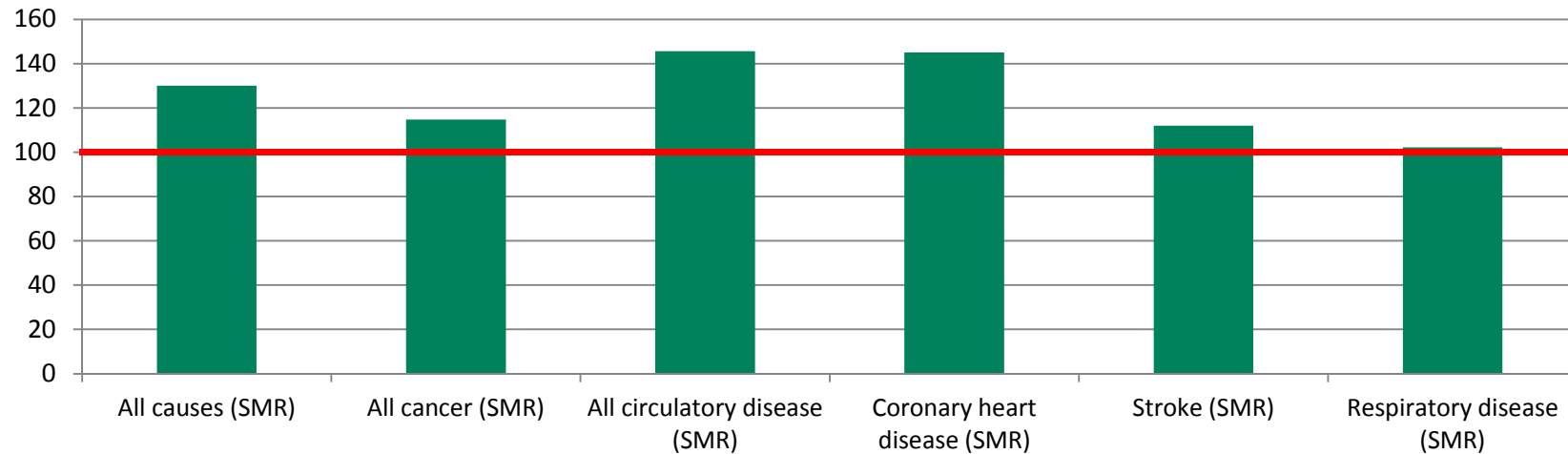

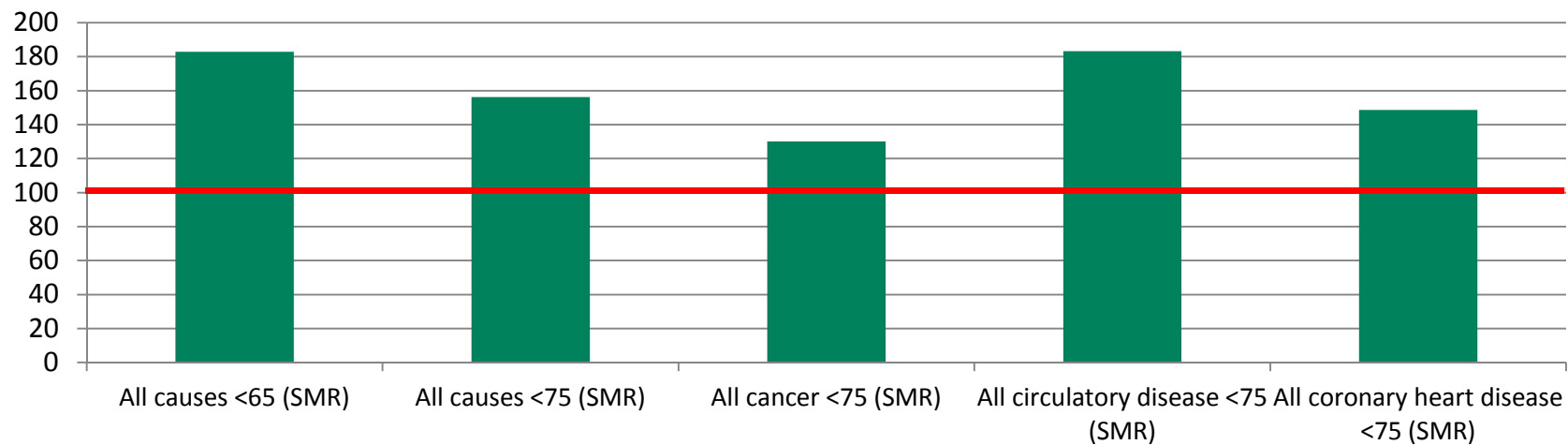
