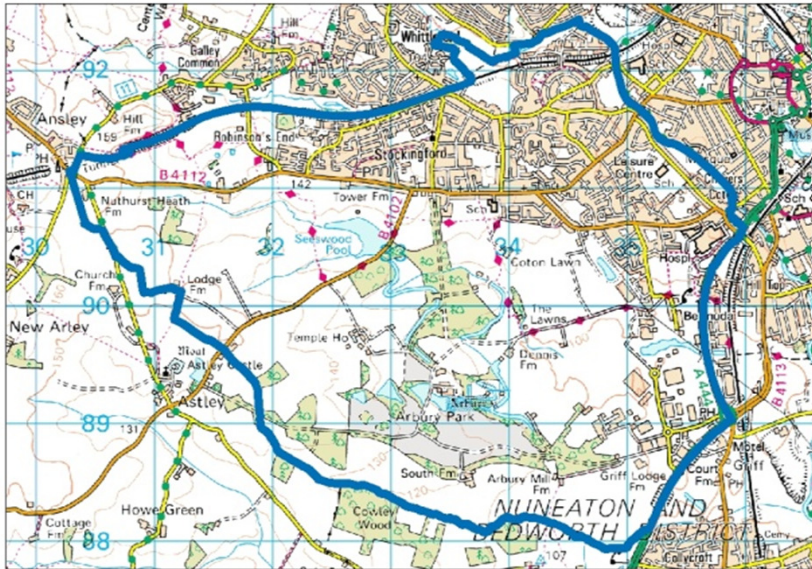


Arbury & Stockingford



The locality of Arbury and Stockingford includes the wards of Kingswood, Bar Pool and Arbury and its namesake County Council Electoral Division. It covers approximately 6 square miles with the residential Stockingford and Bar Pool areas situated in the northernmost part of the locality and the remaining large rural area, including Arbury Park and surrounding woodland, stretching southwards towards Bedworth. 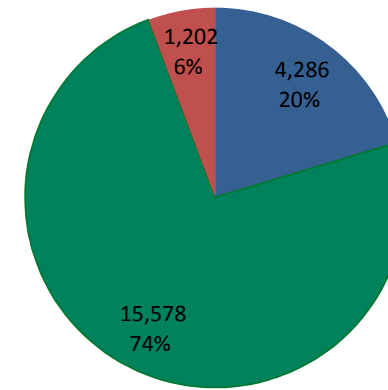

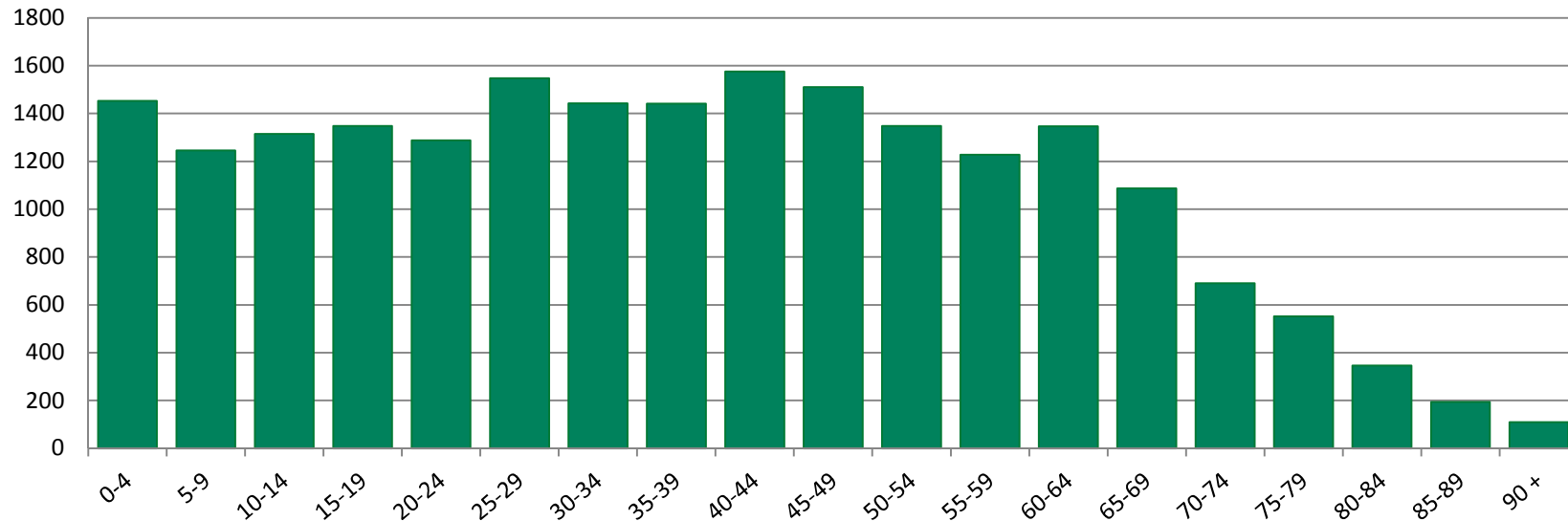

Population By Five Year Age Groups

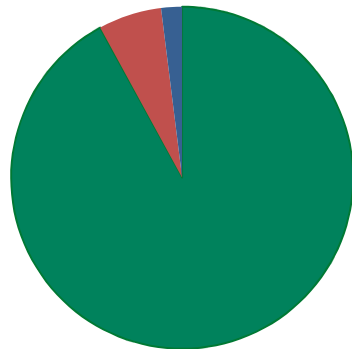

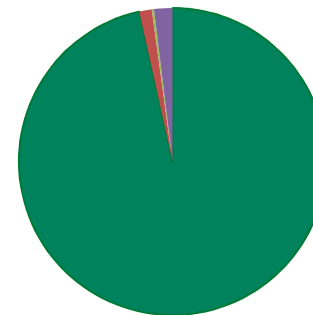

Composition of Locality Population



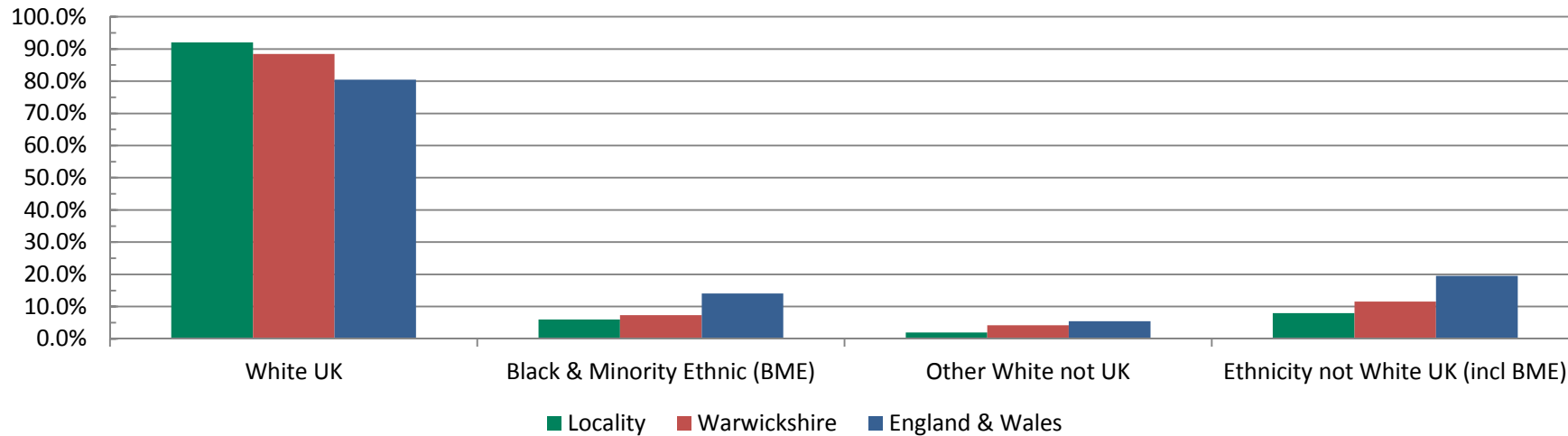

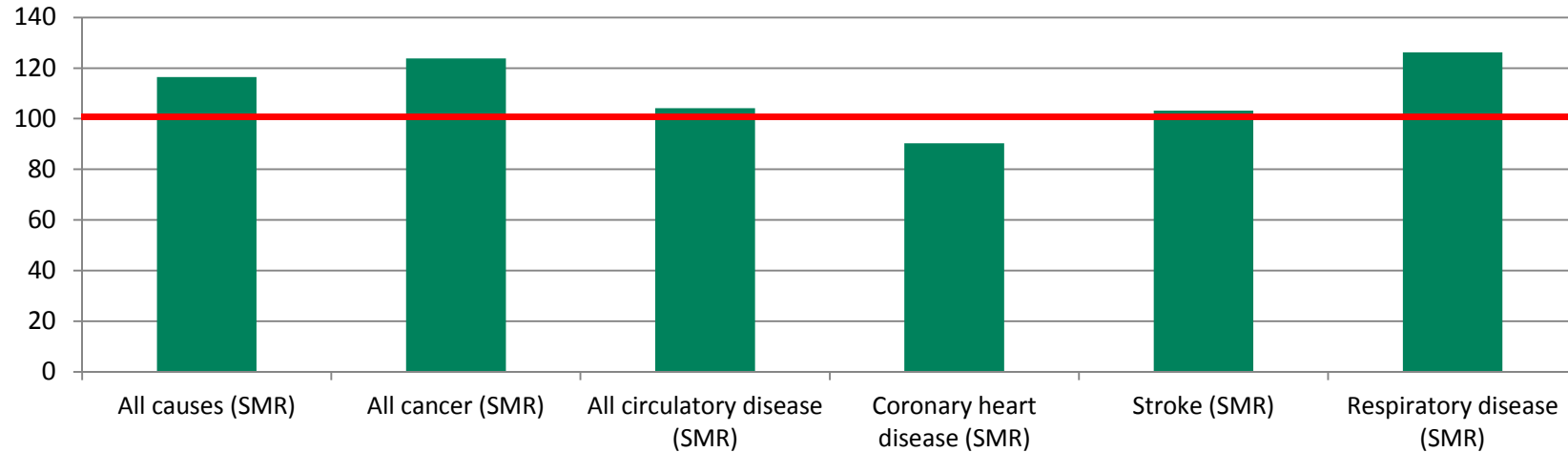

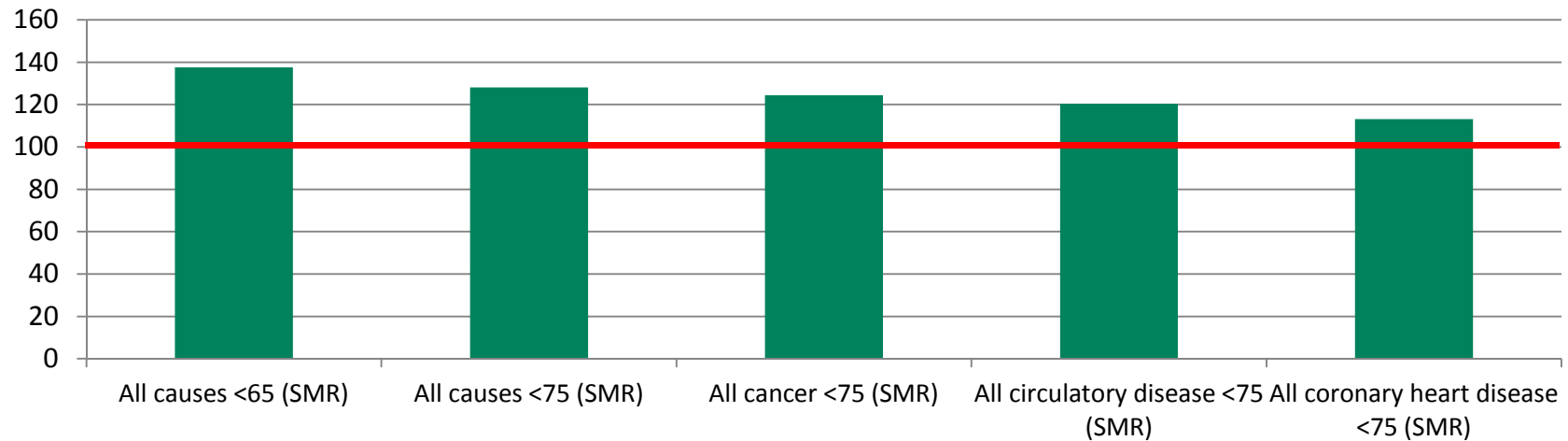
