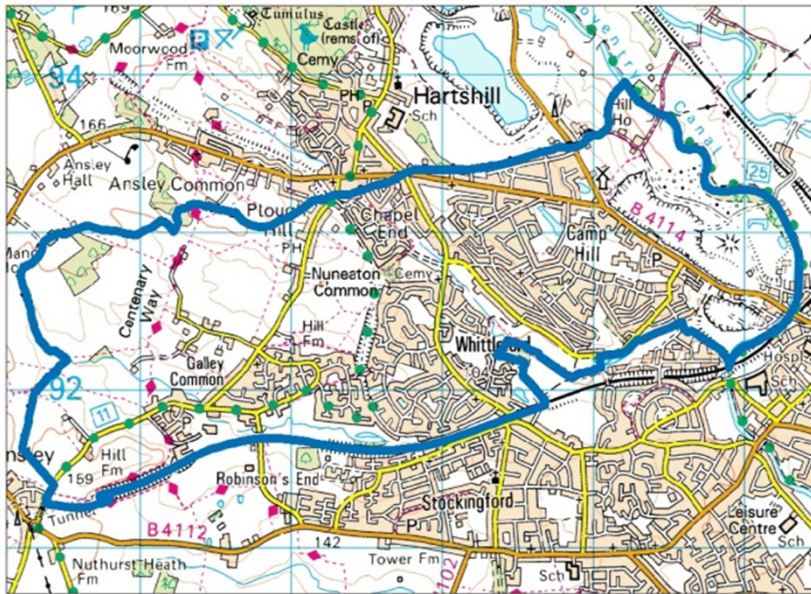


Camp Hill & Galley Common



The locality of Camp Hill and Galley Common lies on the northern edge of Nuneaton & Bedworth Borough. It covers an area of approximately 3 square miles.

The locality contains the primarily residential areas of Camp Hill and Whittleford, with the open spaces of Nuneaton Common and Galley Common to the west of the locality, and Judkins quarry to the east. The north of the locality closely borders the town of Hartshill in North Warwickshire.

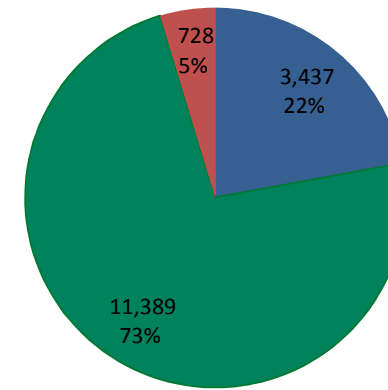

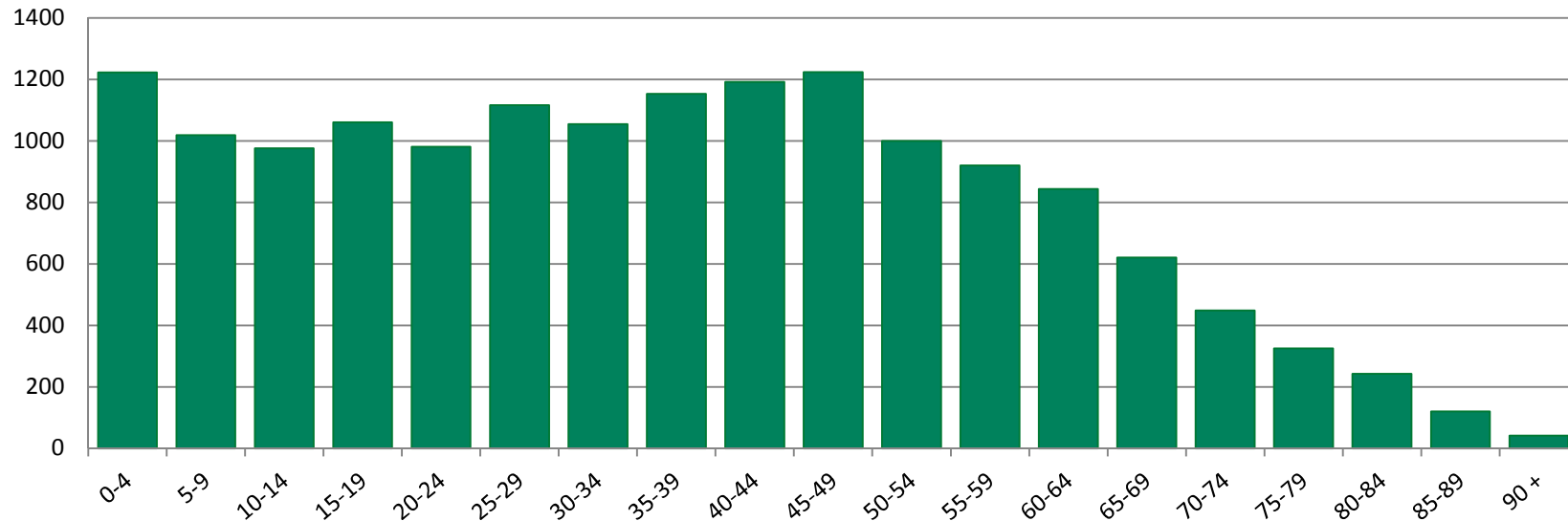

Population By Five Year Age Groups

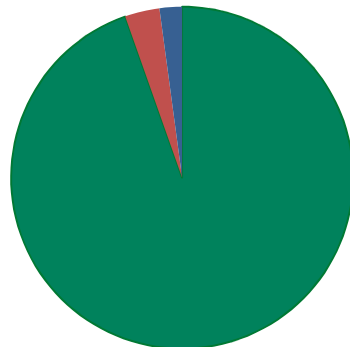

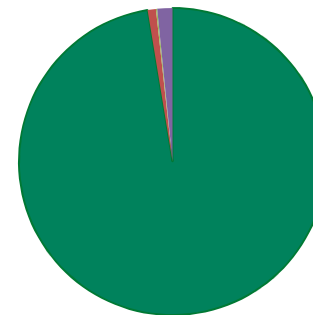

Composition of Locality Population



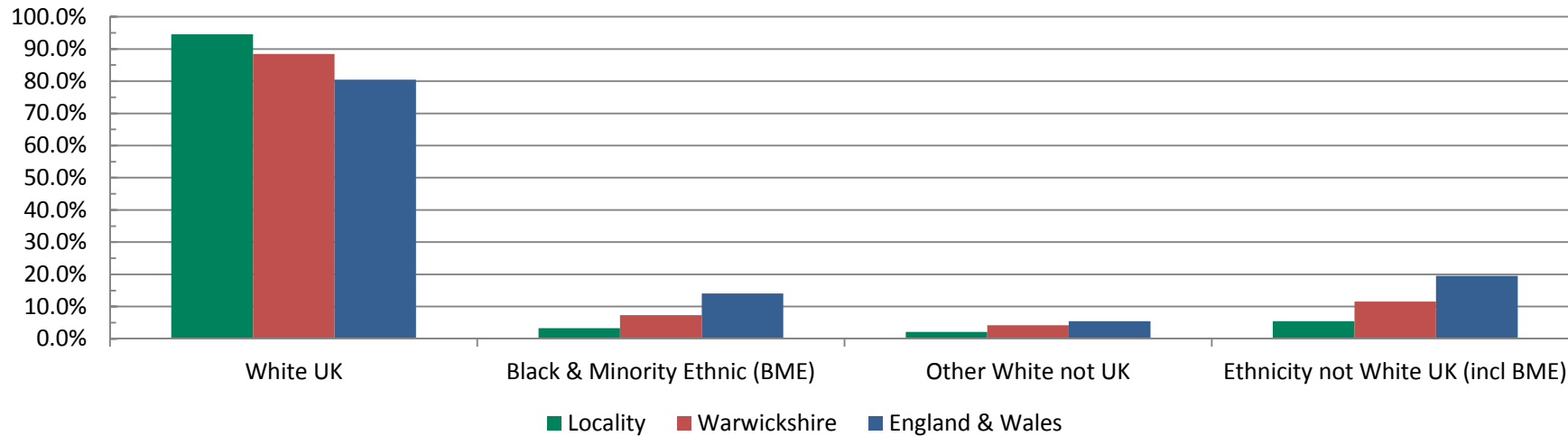

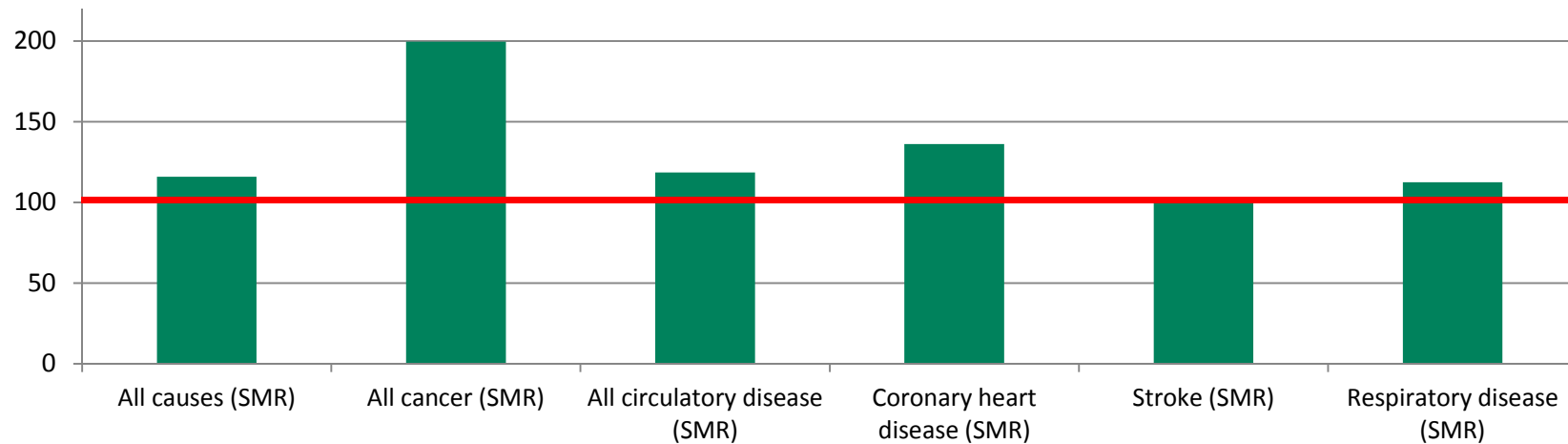

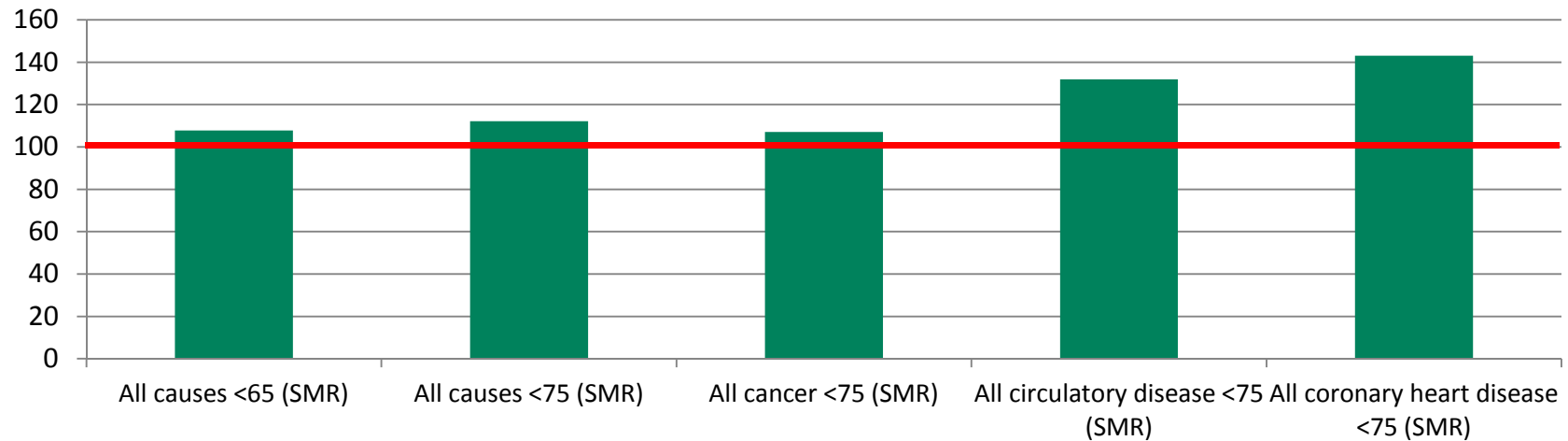
