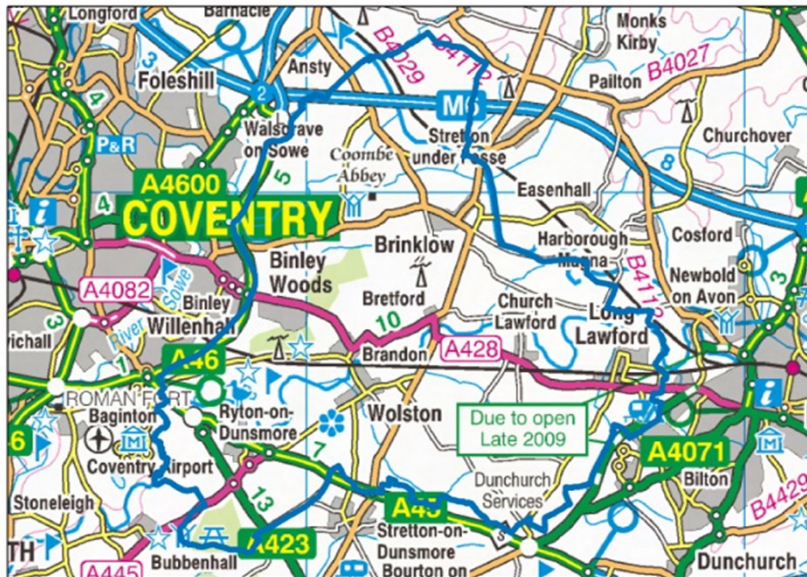


Earl Craven



The locality of Earl Craven comprises the wards of Earl Craven & Wolston, Lawford & King's Newnham and Ryton-on-Dunsmore. The electoral division is Earl Craven and part of Lawford & New Bilton.

It is approximately 30 square miles in area and lies to the west of Rugby Town. It is a largely rural area, the majority of which is in the green belt.

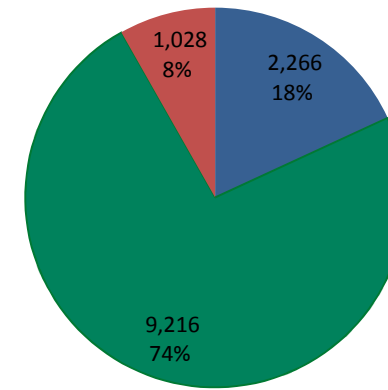

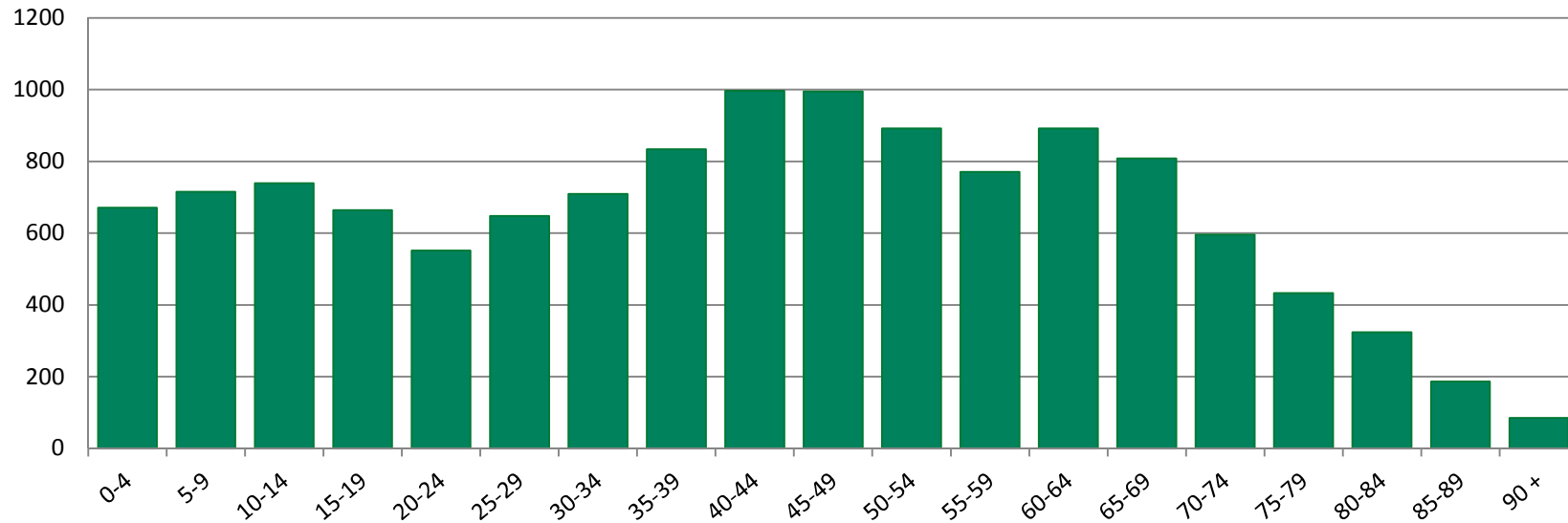

Population By Five Year Age Groups

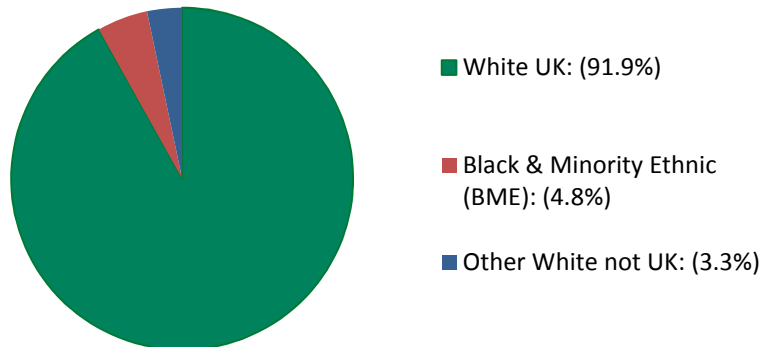

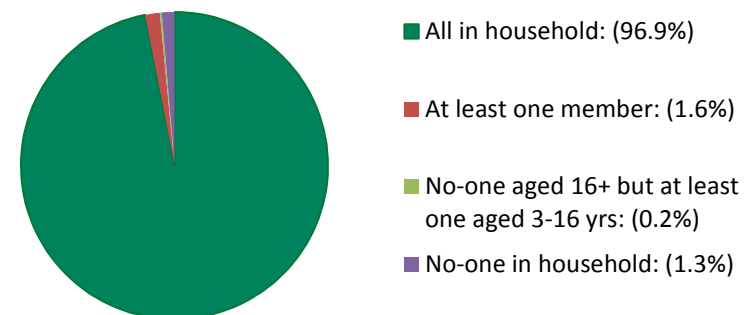

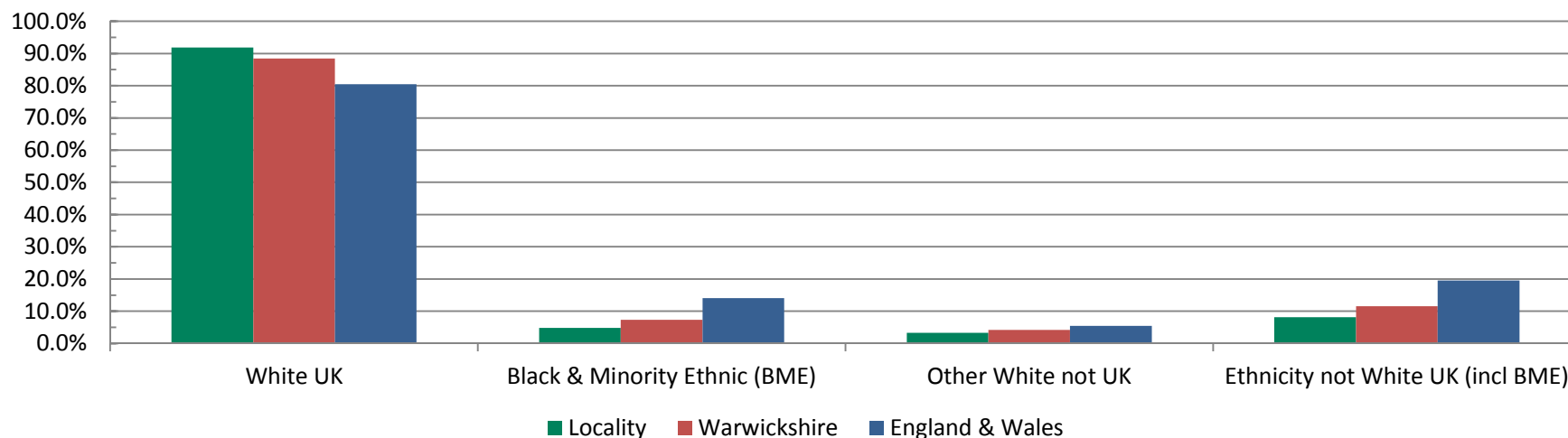
Composition of Locality Population

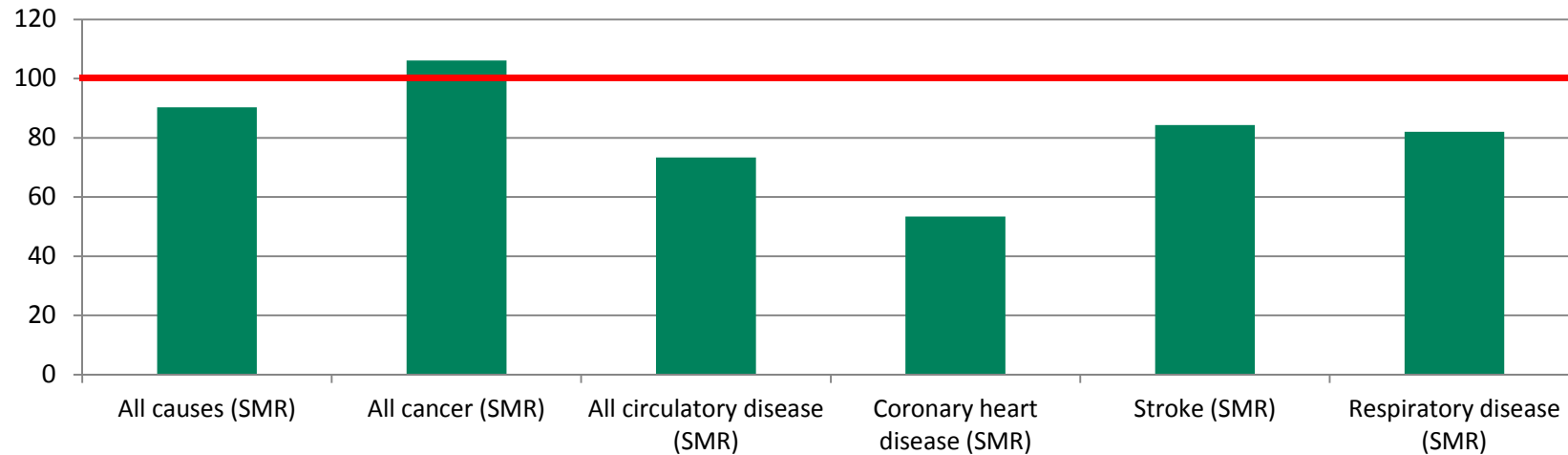

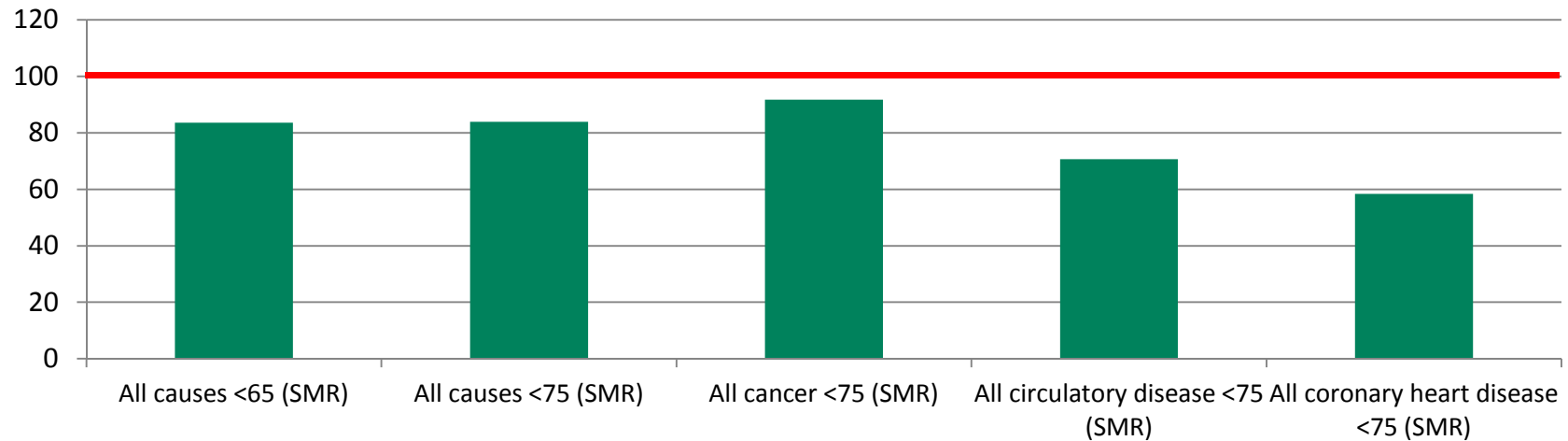
