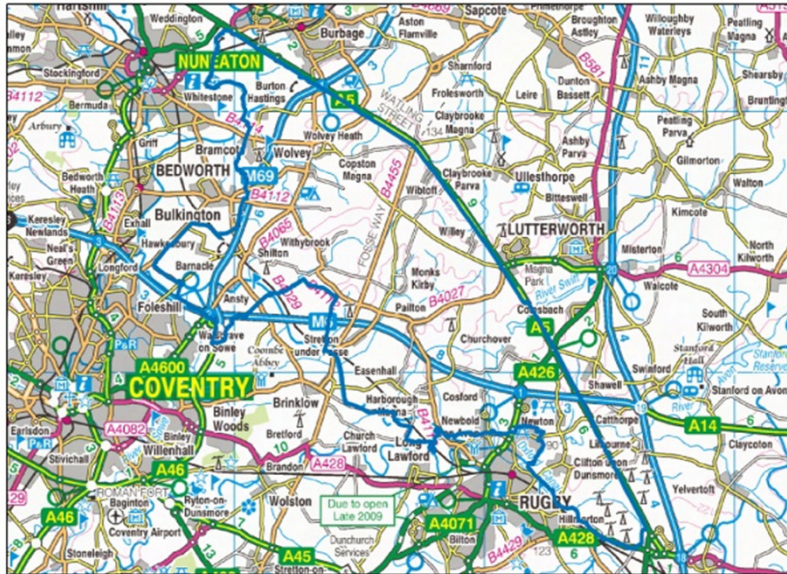


Fosse



The locality of Fosse comprises the wards of Avon & Swift and Fosse and the electoral division of Fosse. It stretches from Nuneaton and Hinckley in the north to the boundary with Northamptonshire in the south.

It is approximately 52 square miles in area and is largely rural. Approximately two thirds of the locality is green belt.

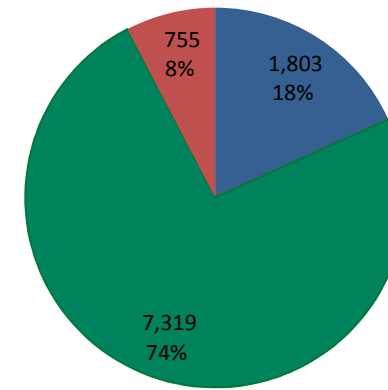

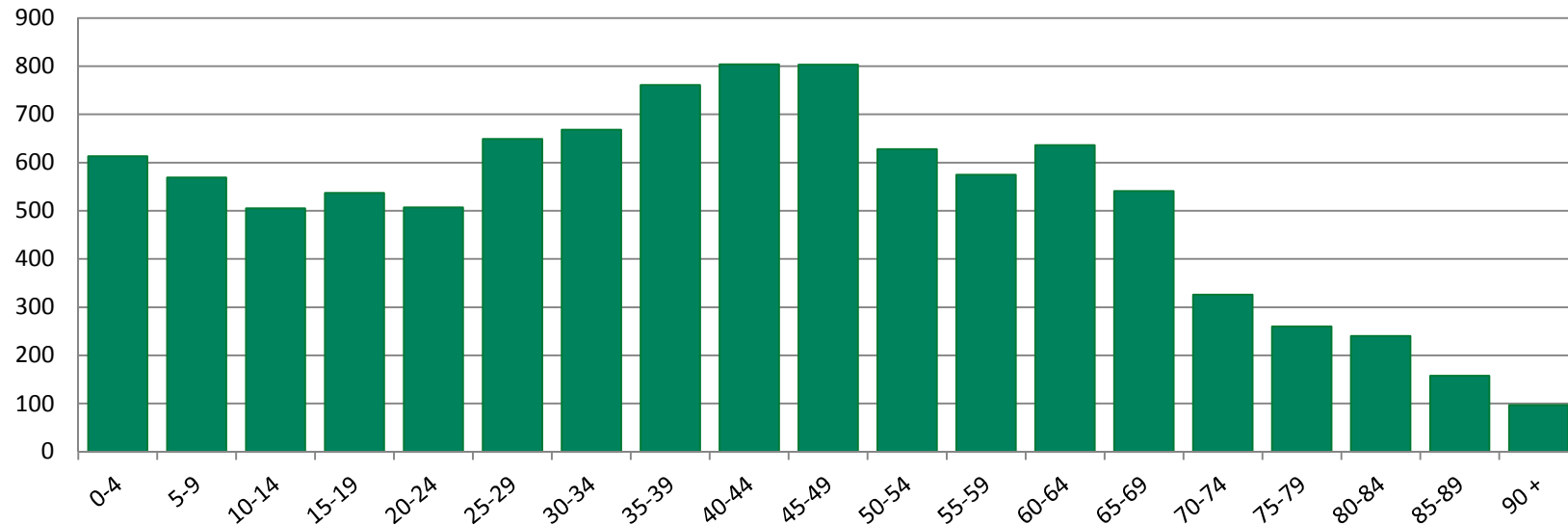

Population By Five Year Age Groups

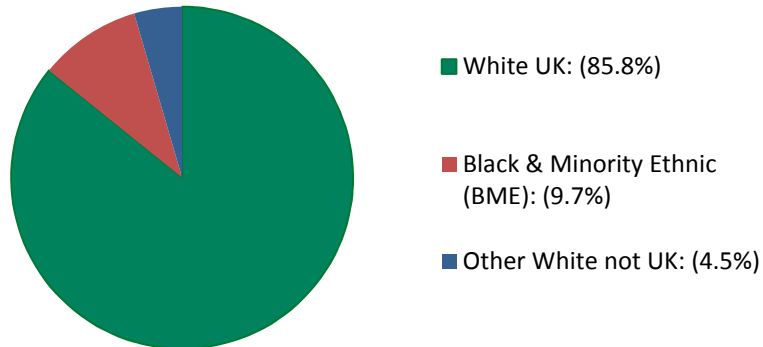

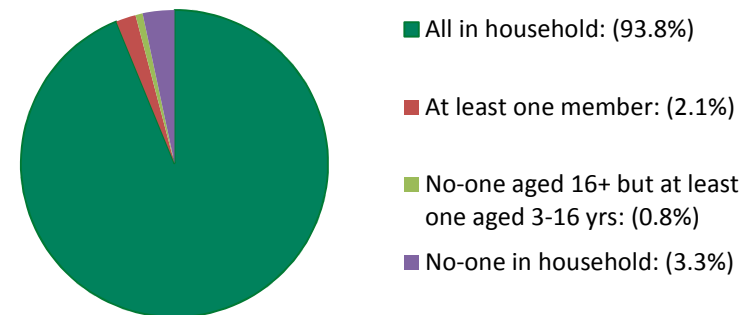

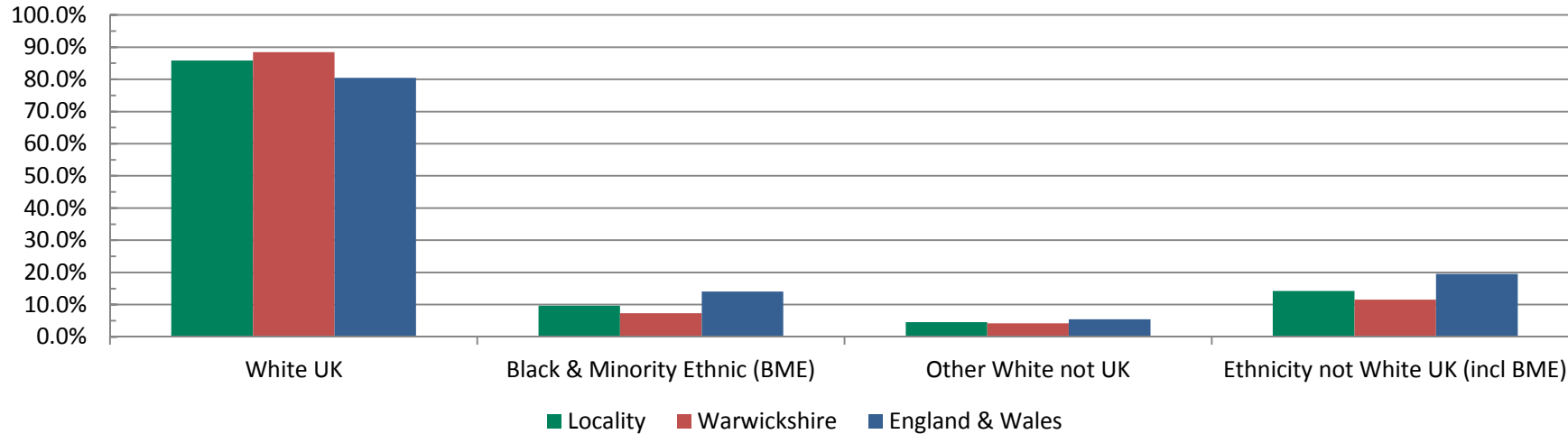
Composition of Locality Population

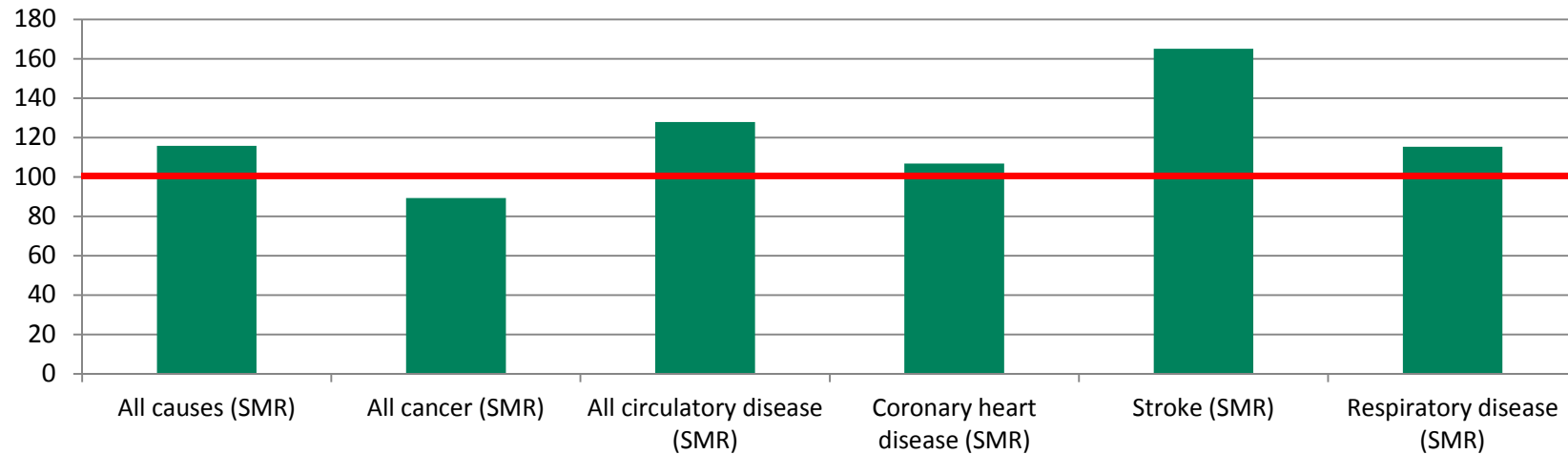

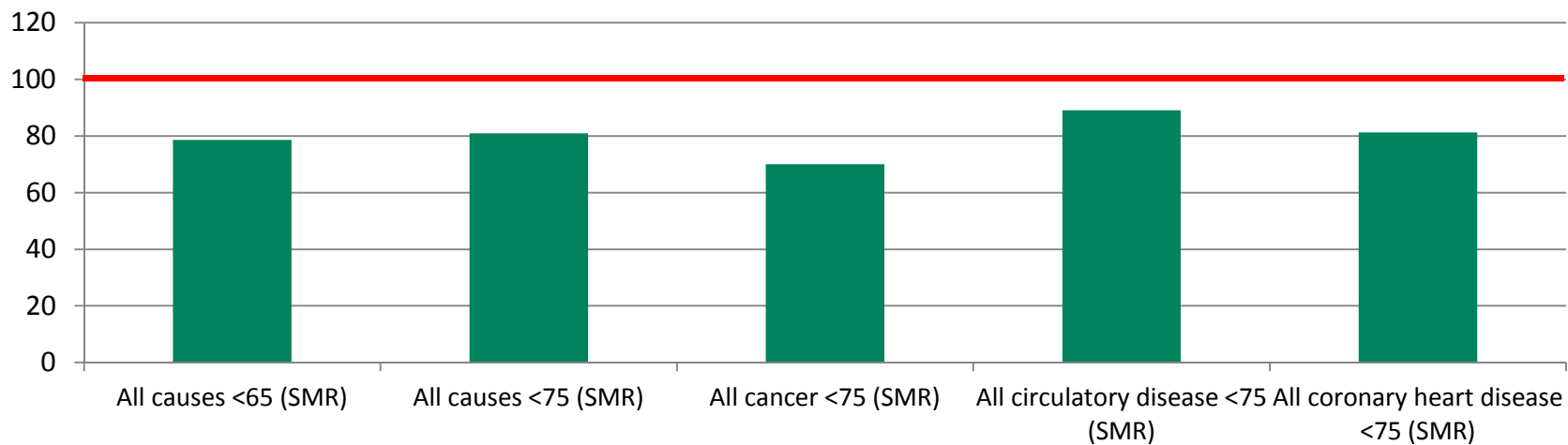

Due to the availability of the data, certain decisions were made that mean that the statistical geographies may differ slightly from administrative geographies.
