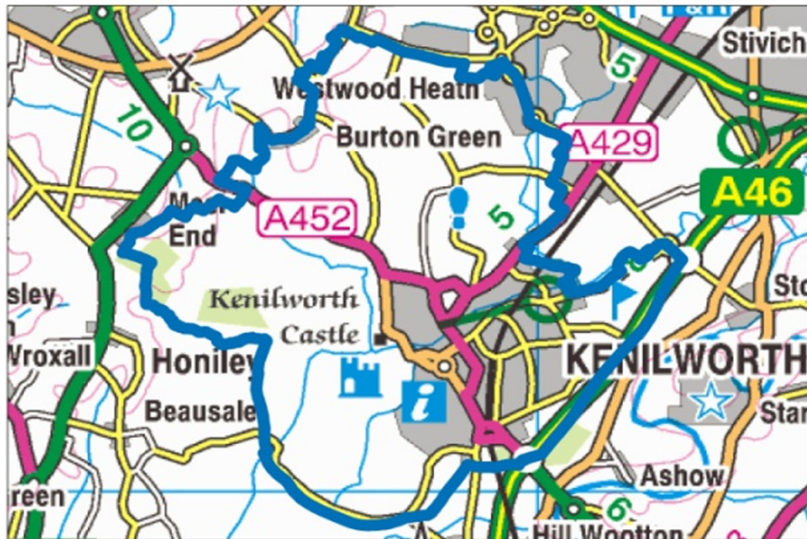


Kenilworth



The Kenilworth locality comprises the wards of Abbey, St John's, Park Hill, a small area of Stoneleigh and the village of Burton Green. It includes the 3 County Council Electoral Divisions of Kenilworth held by 3 County Councillors. 9 District Councillors represent the town, and the Town Council is made up of 16 Councillors.

Aside from the town centre and residential areas, the locality is rural and sparsely populated. Part of the University of Warwick campus falls into the north-east part of the locality. Kenilworth Castle is a popular tourist attraction.

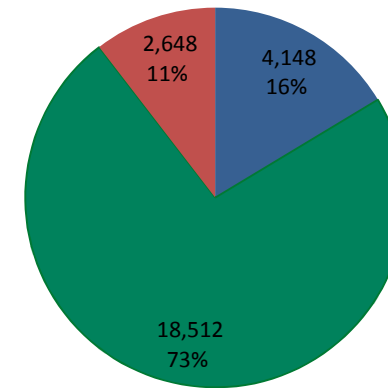

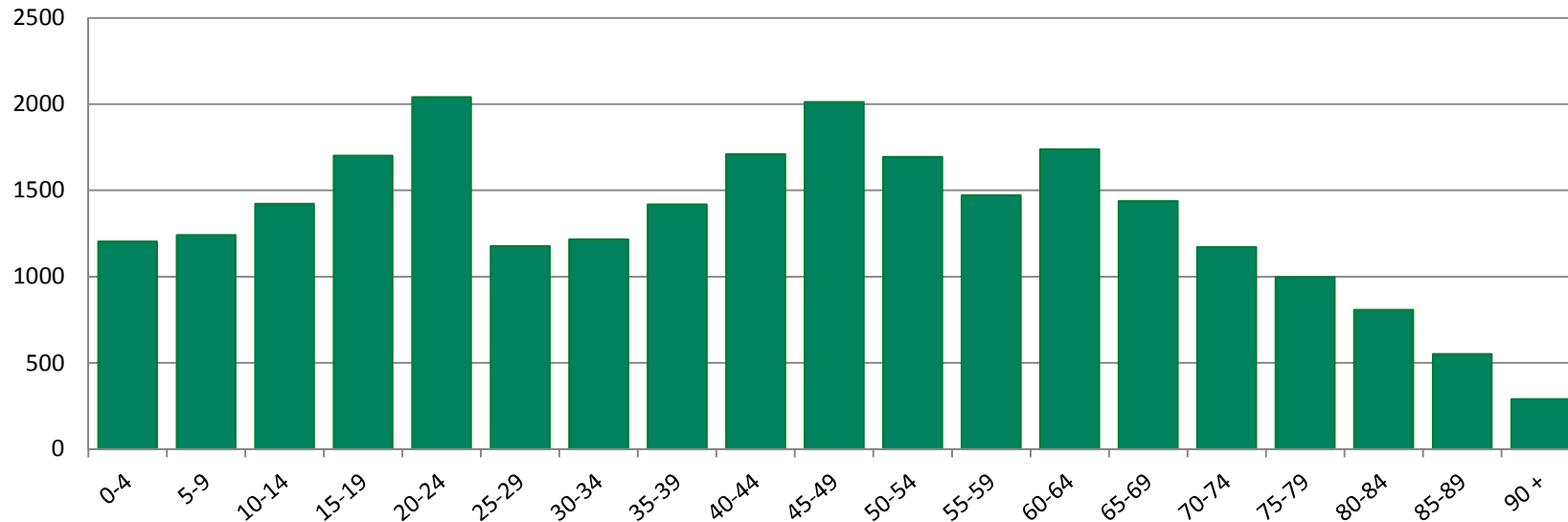

Population By Five Year Age Groups

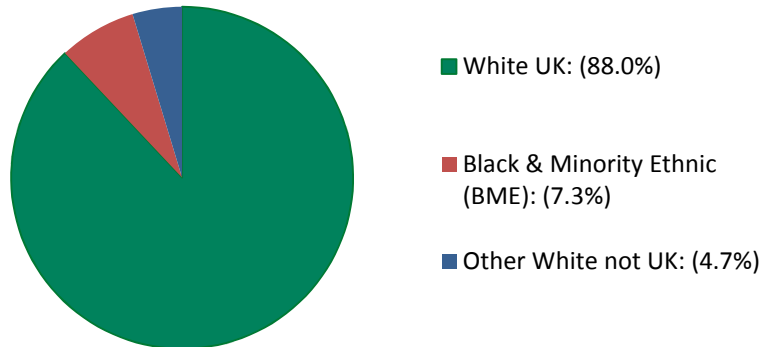

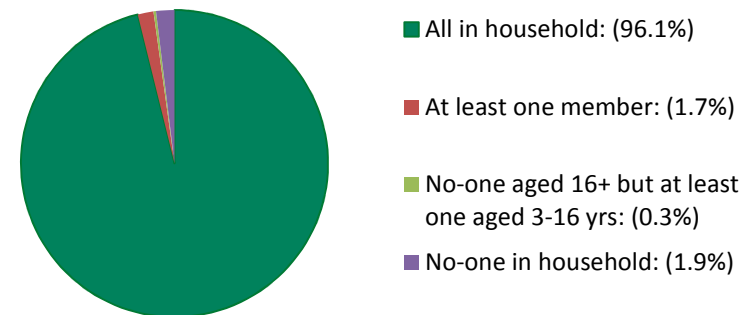

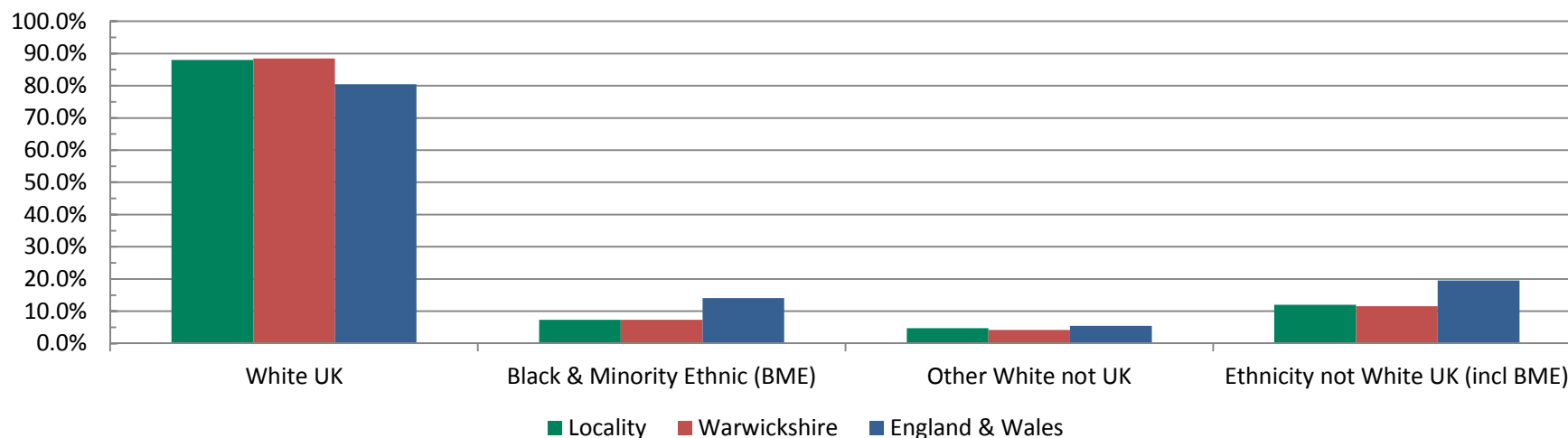
Composition of Locality Population

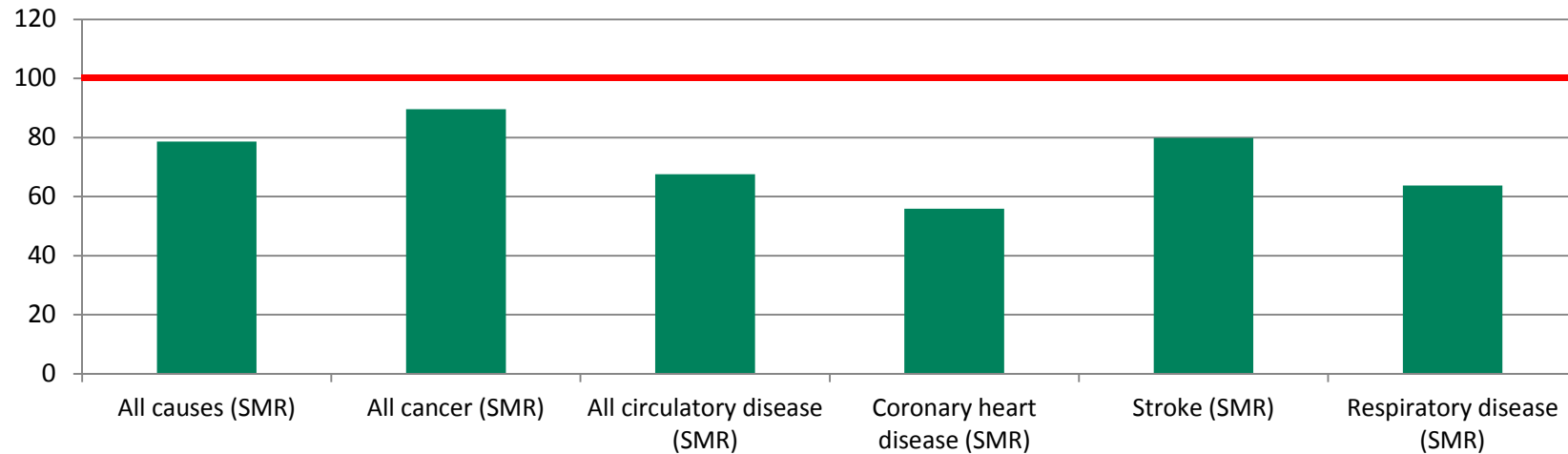

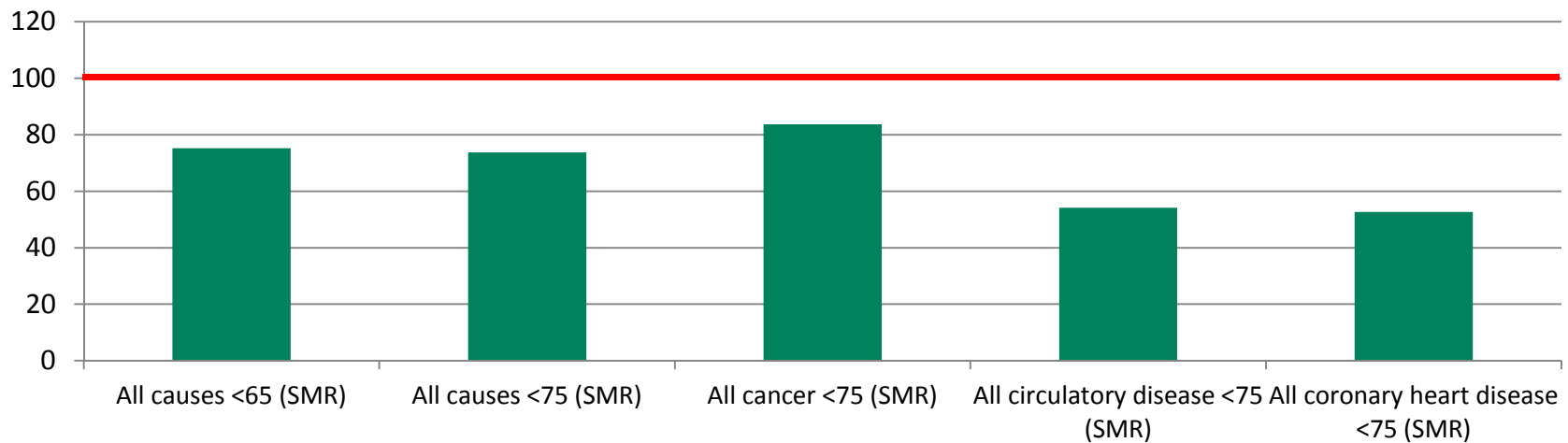
