

North Leamington



The North Leamington Locality has the largest population of all the localities in the District & comprises the wards of Milverton, Clarendon, Manor & Crown and the County Council Electoral Divisions of Milverton & Leamington North. The locality covers an area of approx. 4 square miles. The locality is primarily residential except for the main town centre & the Champion Hills & Newbold Comyn areas. However, there is a considerable mix of housing ranging from new town centre flats to post-war local authority stock to large regency style properties.

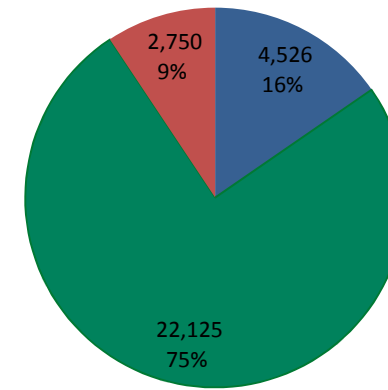

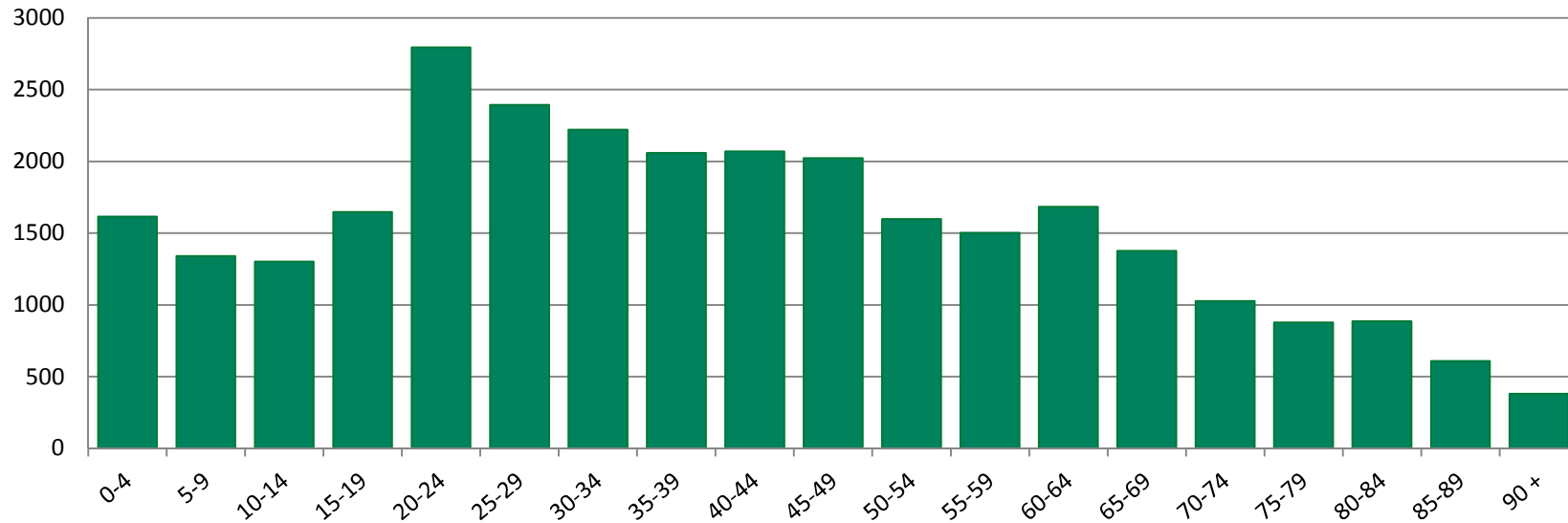

Population By Five Year Age Groups

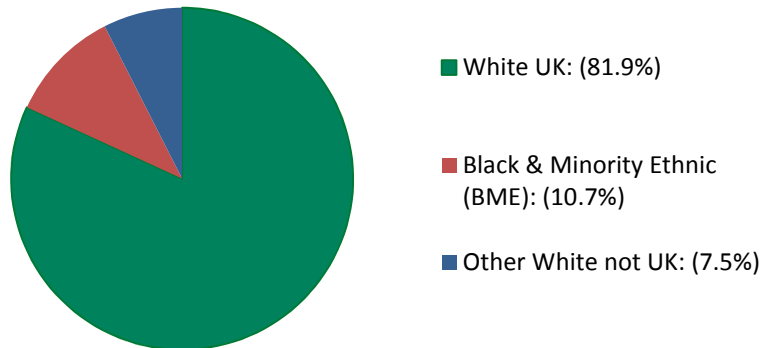

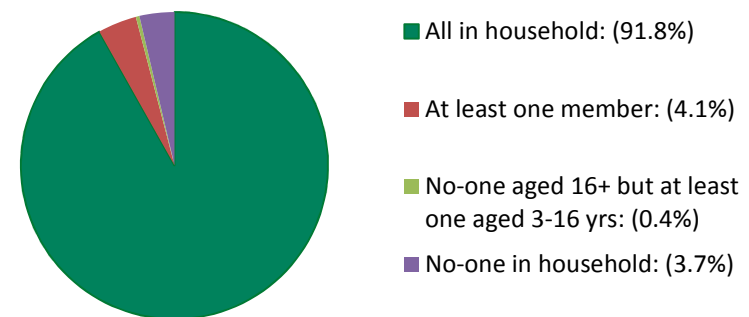

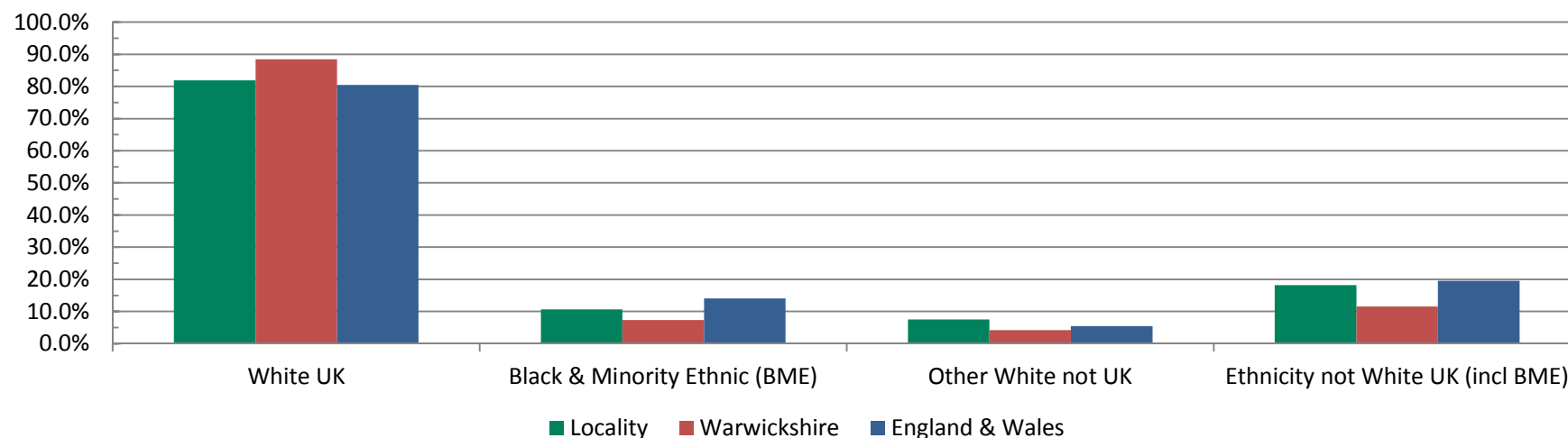
Composition of Locality Population

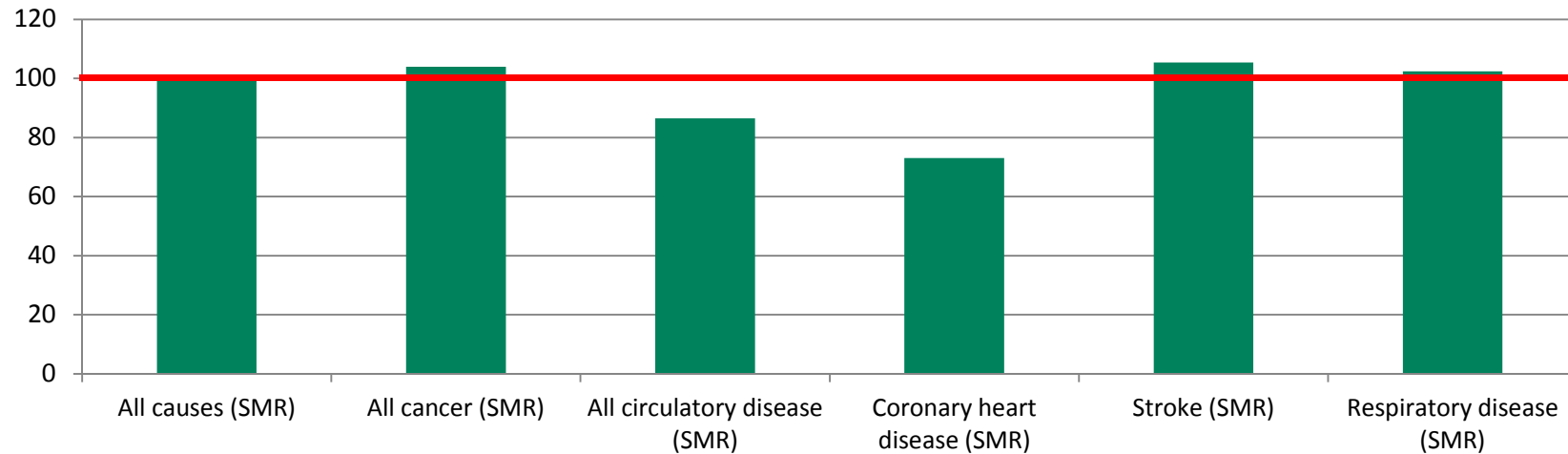

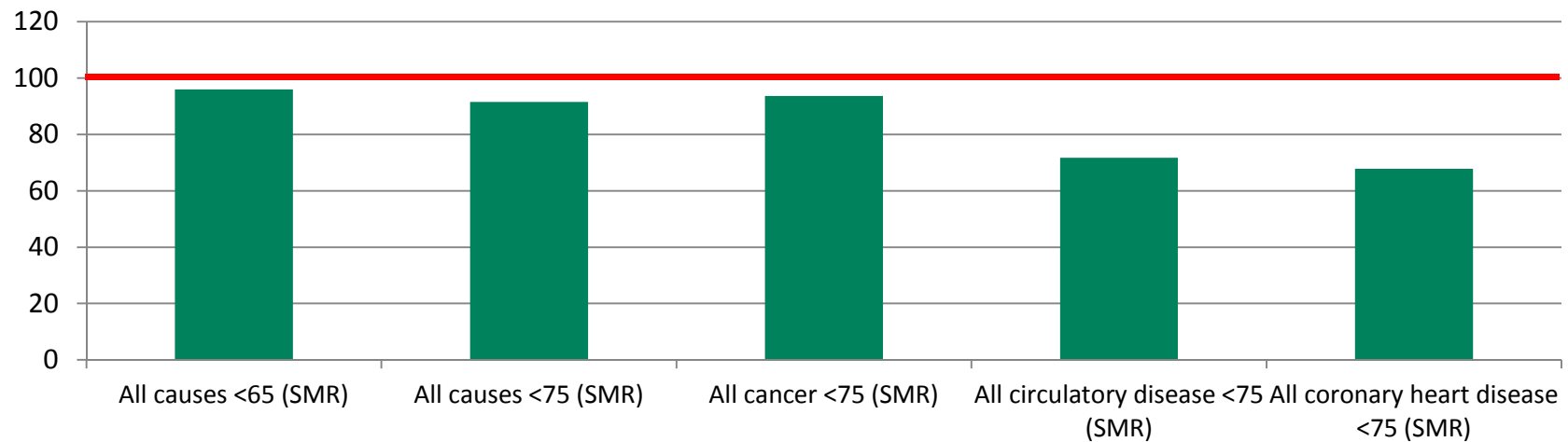
