


Warwickshire County Council - Health & Wellbeing Locality Reports 2014

North Warwickshire - East



The locality of North Warwickshire East comprises the wards of Atherstone North, Atherstone Central, Atherstone South and Mancetter, and Hartshill. This area also includes the County Council Electoral Divisions of Atherstone and Hartshill. The locality covers an area of approximately 8 square miles. The large town of Atherstone together with adjoining Mancetter is located in the north of the locality with the smaller settlement of Hartshill surrounded by farmland and woodland on the southern edge bordering Nuneaton & Bedworth.




Mortality & causes of death - All Ages, 2006 to 2010

Due to the availability of the data, certain decisions were made that mean that the statistical geographies may differ slightly from administrative geographies. Therefore, in cases where a LSOA crossed the boundaries of multiple localities , a decision was made to allocate the whole LSOA to a single locality.

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
