

North Warwickshire - North



The locality of North Warwickshire North comprises the wards of Newton Regis and Warton, Polesworth East, Polesworth West, Dordon, and Baddesley and Grendon. It also includes the County Council Electoral Divisions of Polesworth and Baddesley. The locality covers an area of approximately 30 square miles.

Aside from the town of Polesworth and the M42 and A5 which run through the heart of the locality, the area is primarily rural and sparsely populated with a scattering of small villages and hamlets.

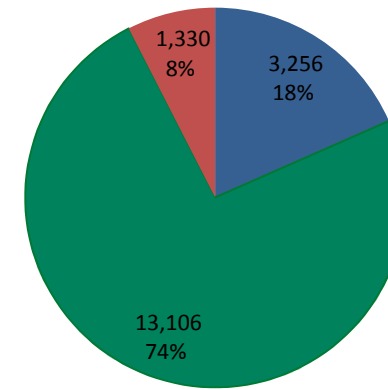

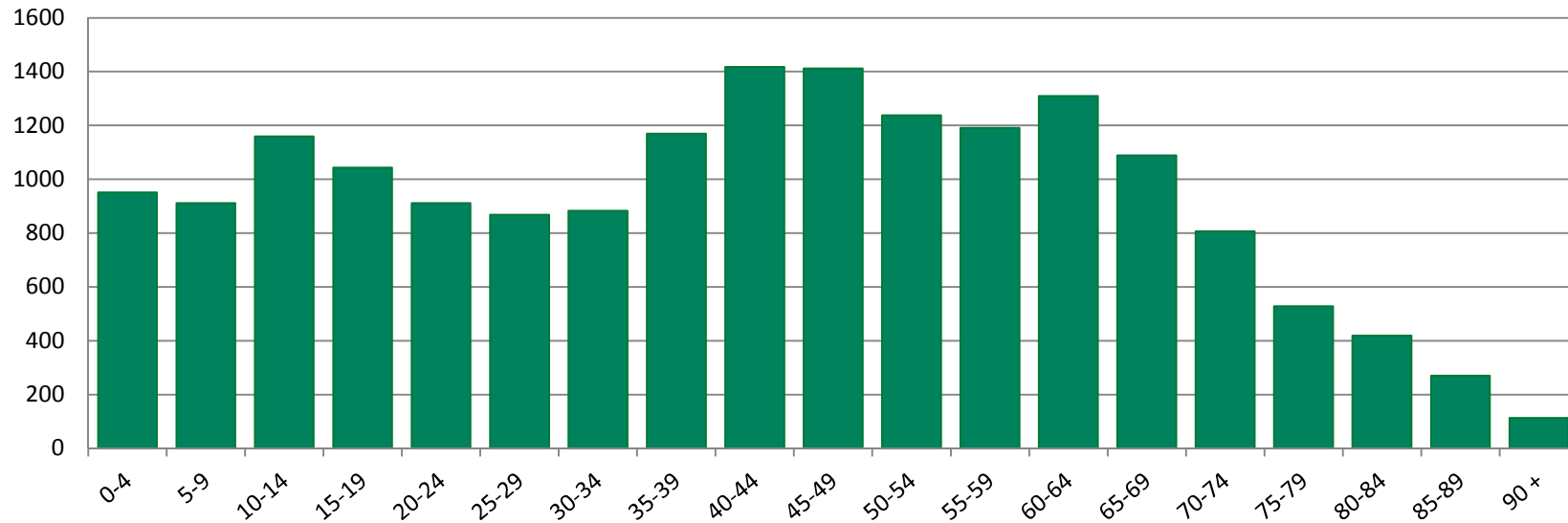

Population By Five Year Age Groups

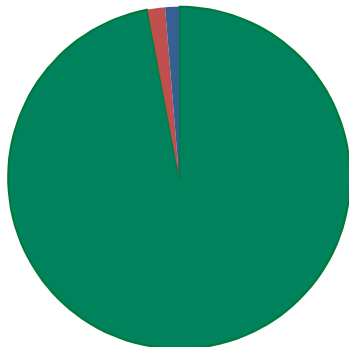

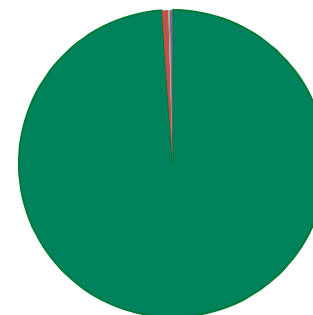

Composition of Locality Population



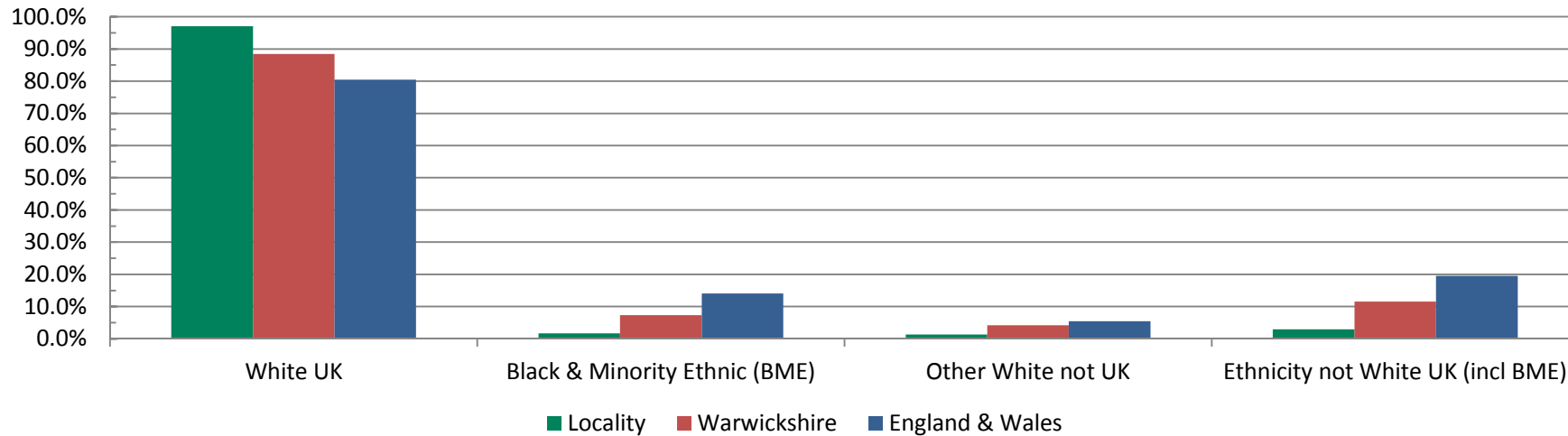

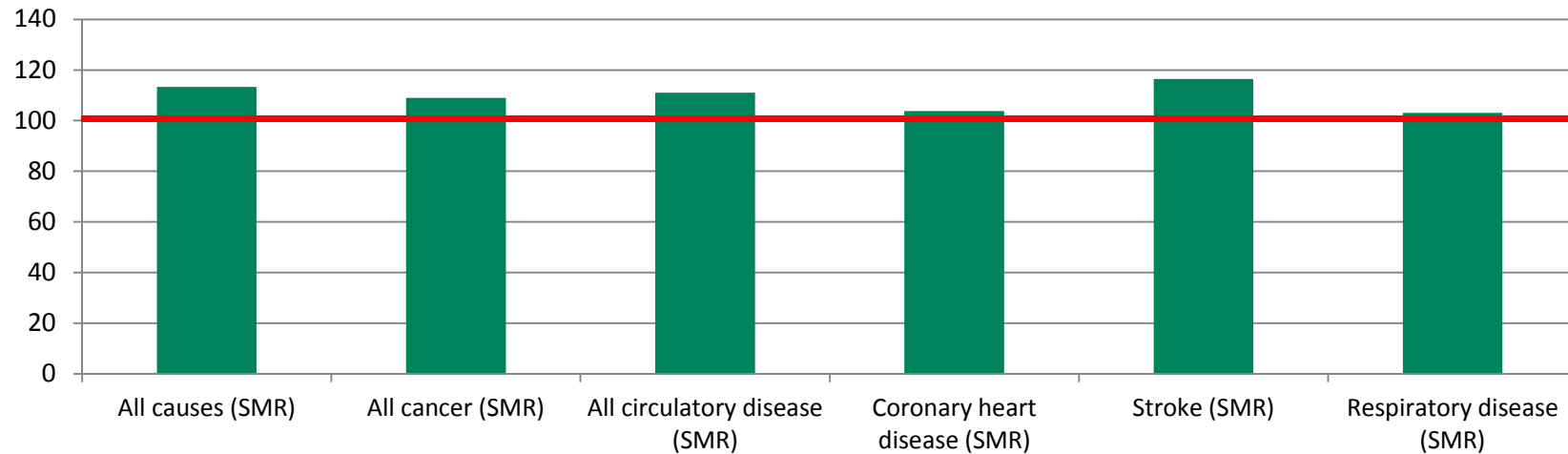

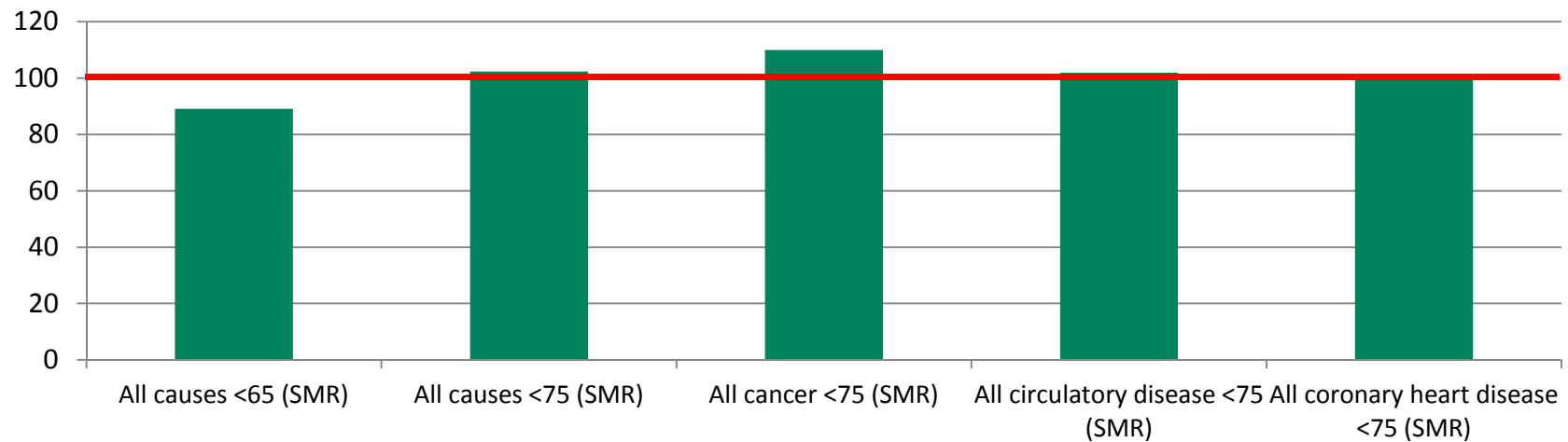
