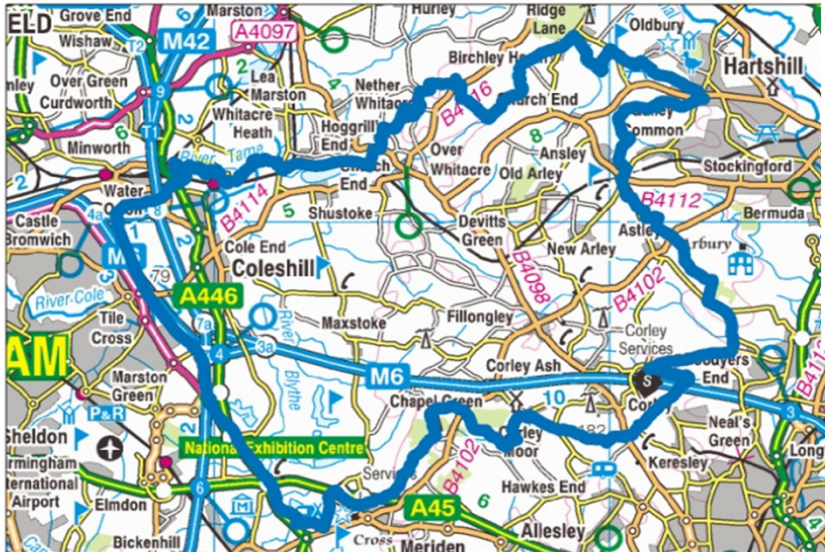


North Warwickshire - South



The locality of North Warwickshire South comprises the wards of Coleshill North, Coleshill South, Arley and Whitacre and Fillongley, and includes the Electoral Divisions of Coleshill and Arley. The locality covers an area of approximately 43 square miles. North Warwickshire-South is predominantly rural in nature and contains a scattering of villages, hamlets and farms, with the exception of the town of Coleshill situated next to the M42.

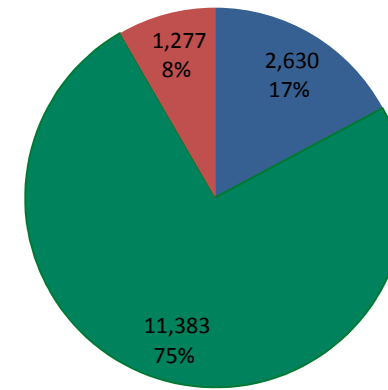

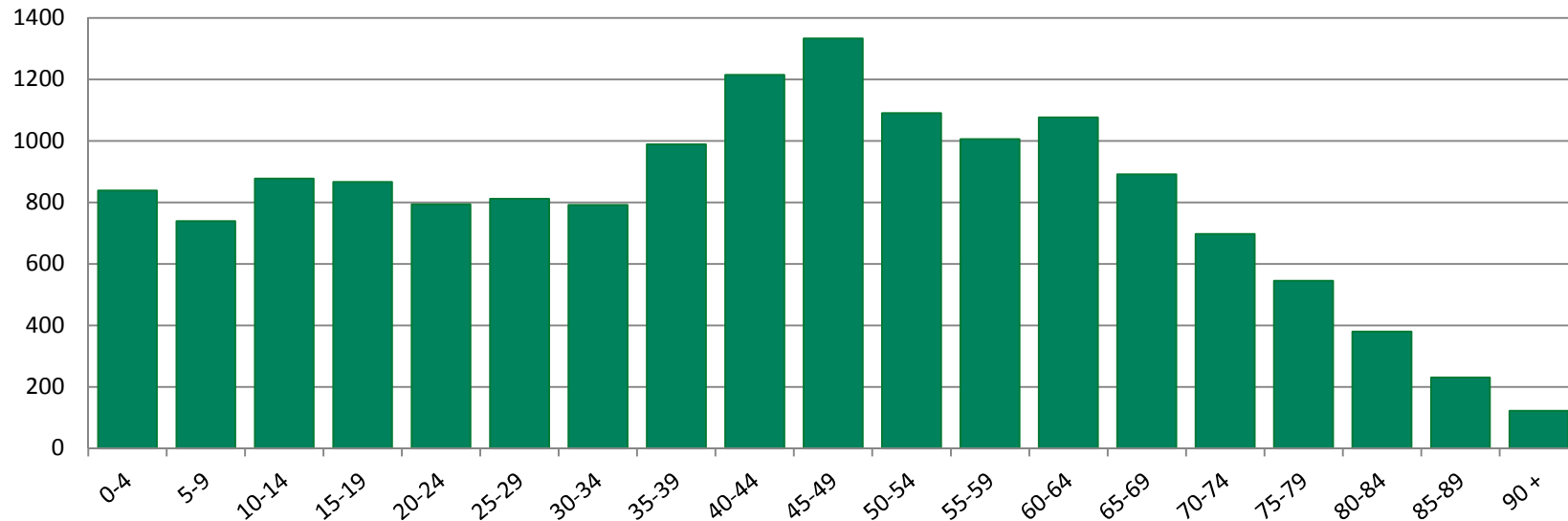

Population By Five Year Age Groups

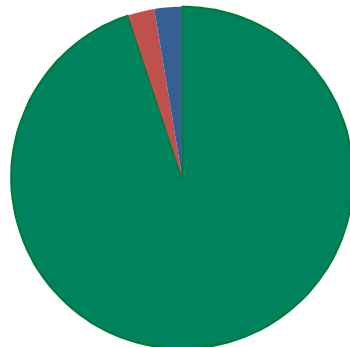

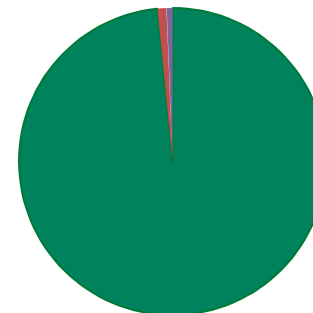

Composition of Locality Population



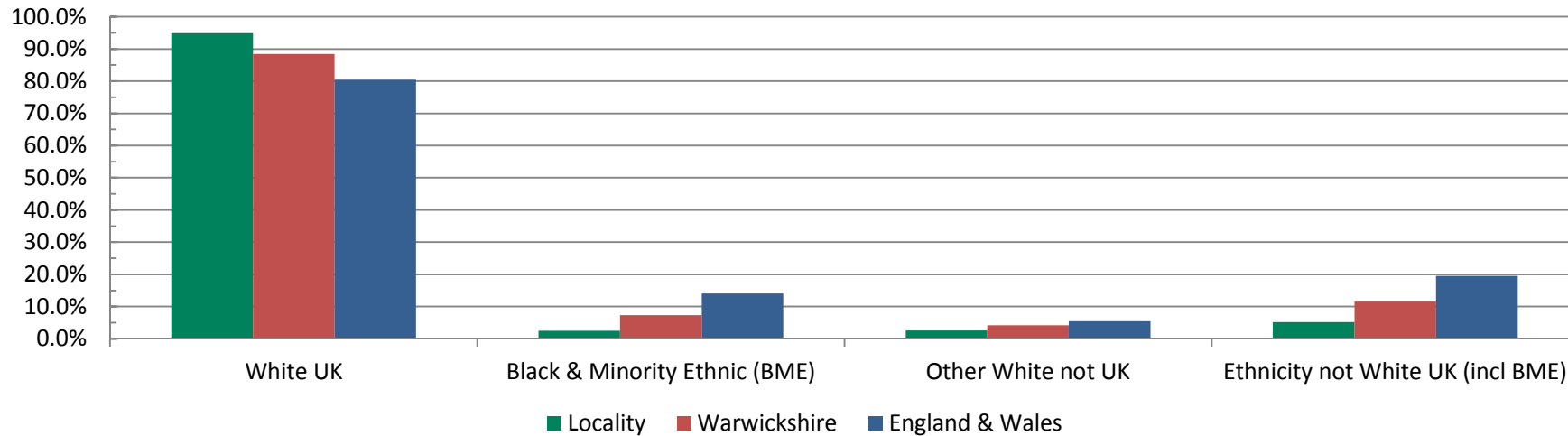

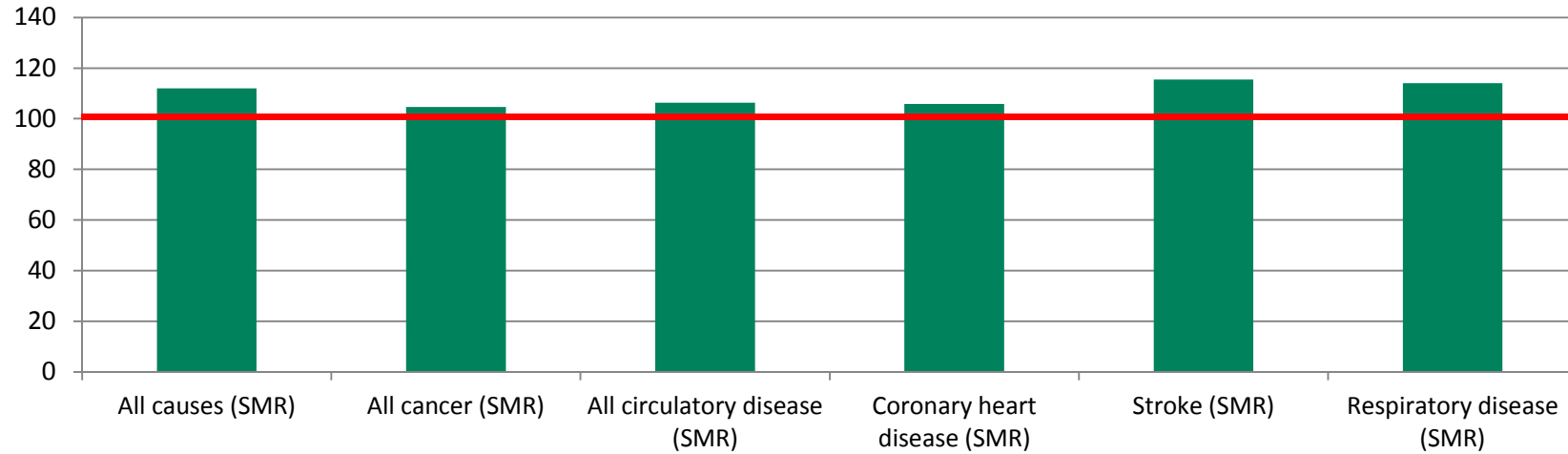

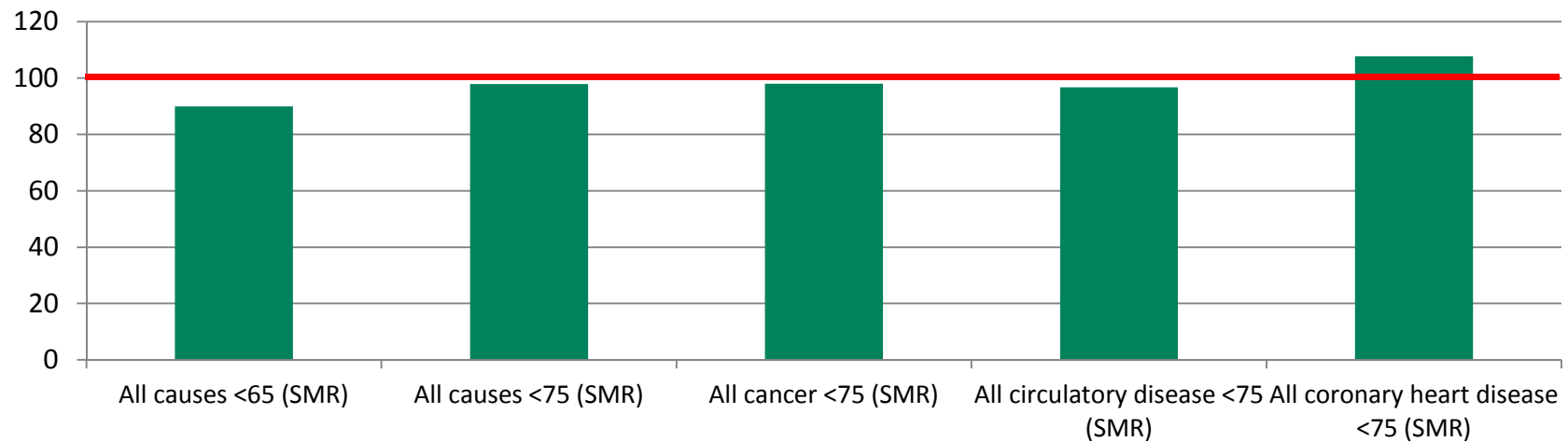
