

North Warwickshire - West



The locality of North Warwickshire West lies in the north-west corner of the County, adjoining the West Midlands conurbation. It comprises the wards of Water Orton, Hurley and Wood End, Curdsworth and Kingsbury and includes the County Council Electoral Divisions of Water Orton and Kingsbury. North Warwickshire-West is essentially rural in character and contains a scattering of small villages, hamlets and farms, with the exception of the larger settlement of Kingsbury and the Hams Hall Industrial Estate.

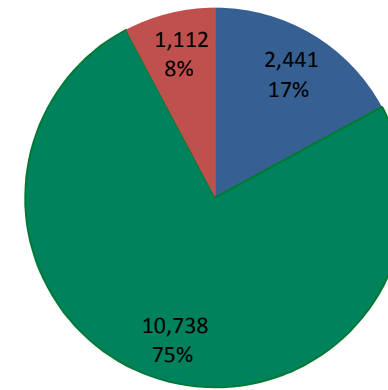

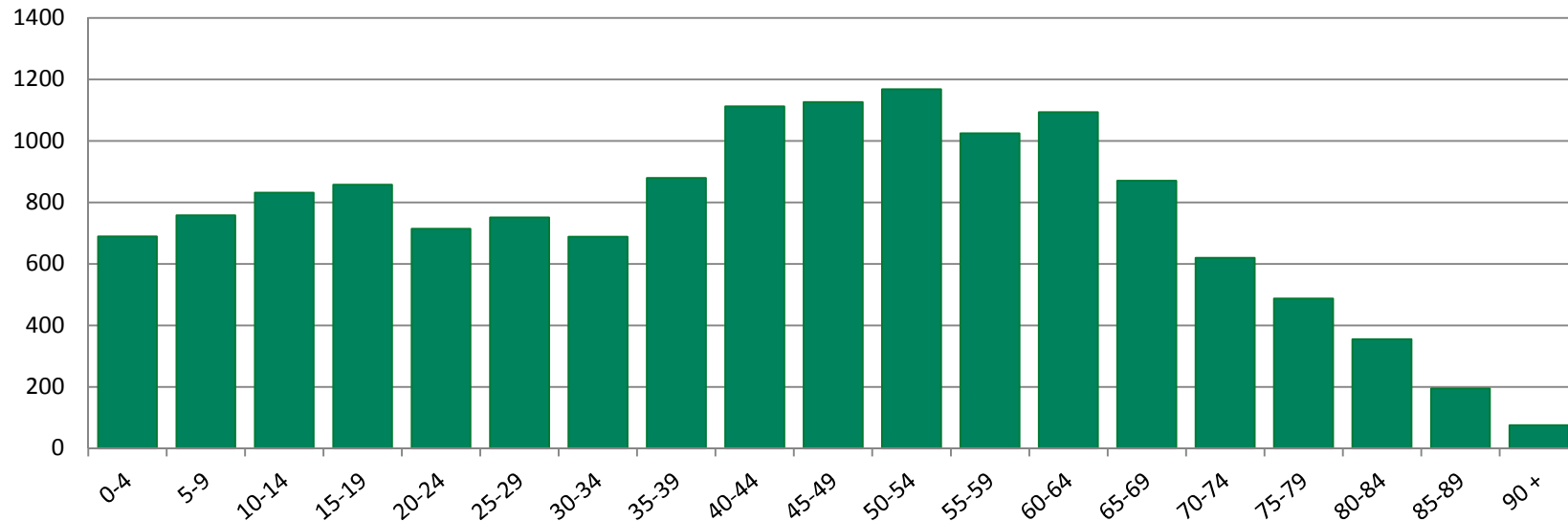

## Population By Five Year Age Groups

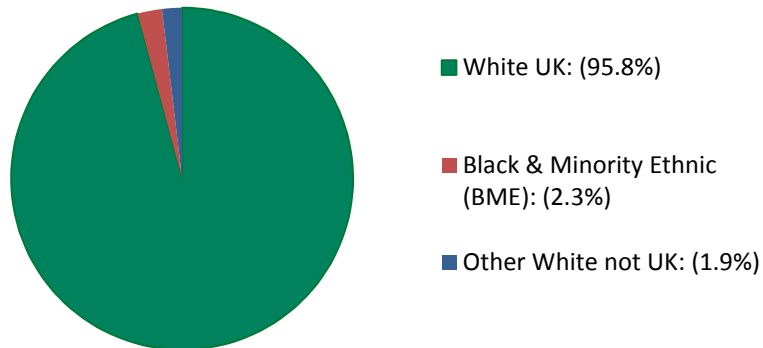

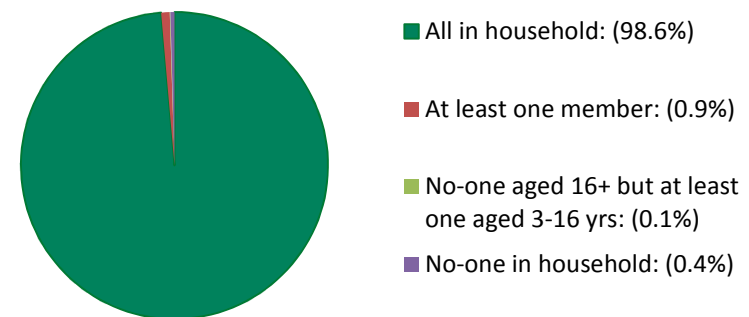

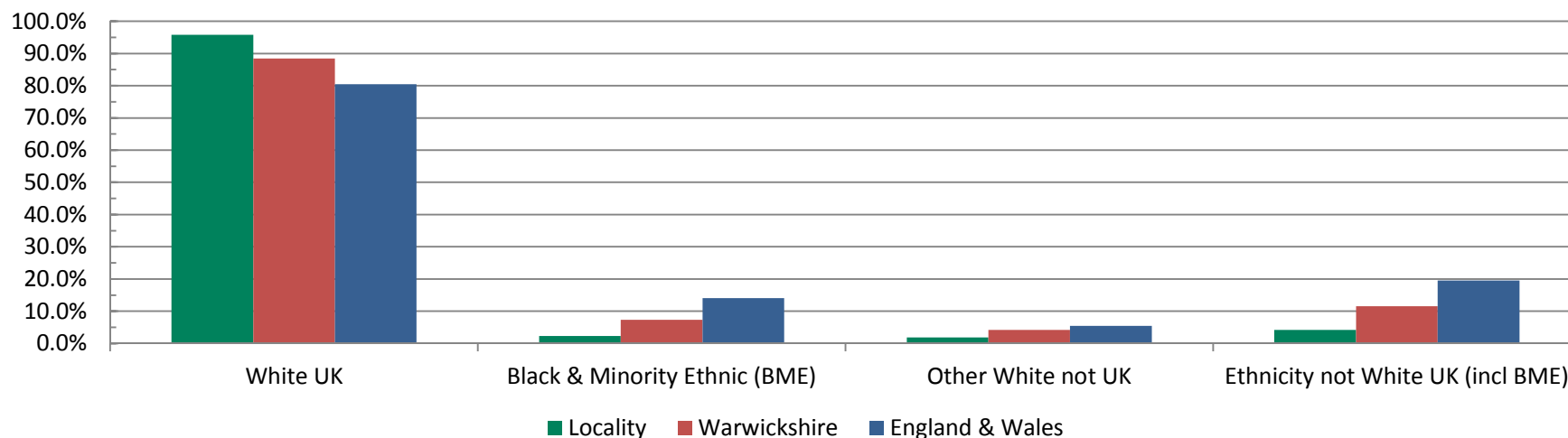
### Composition of Locality Population

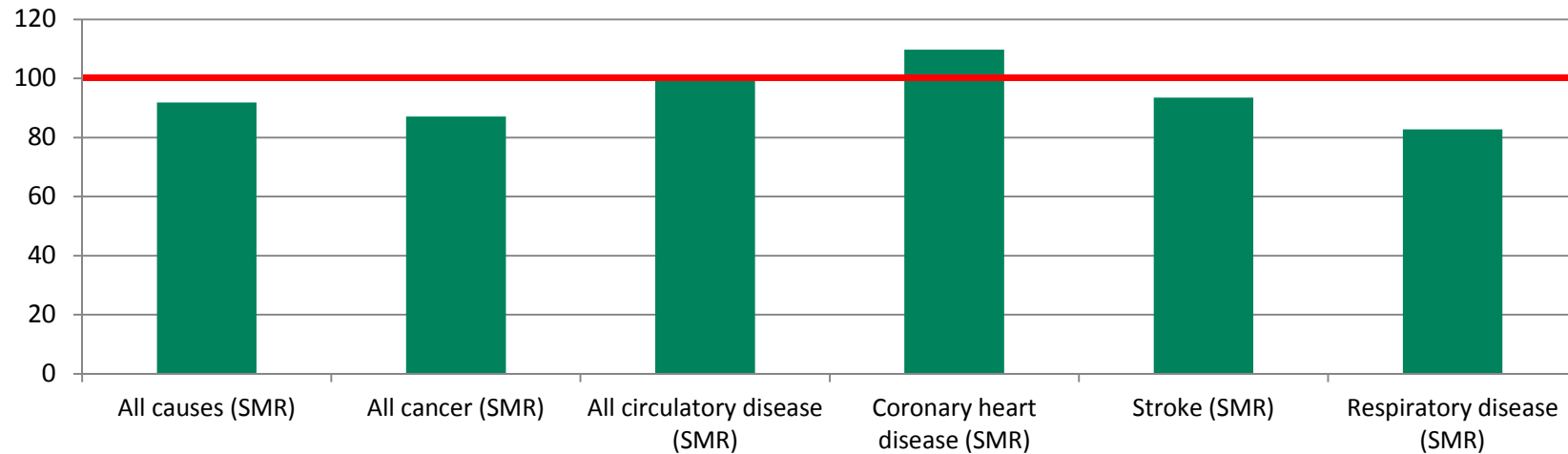

### Mortality & causes of death - All Ages, 2006 to 2010

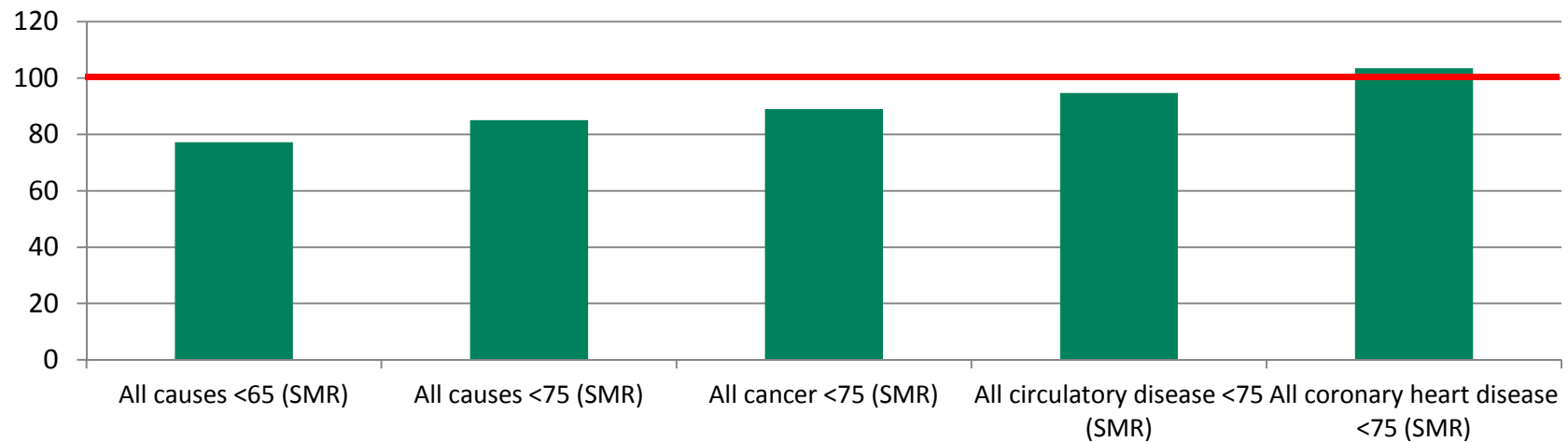
