The Shipston Locality comprises the wards of Ettington, Quinton, Tredington, Vale of the Red Horse, Brailes, Shipston and Long Compton. It includes the County Council Electoral Divisions of Stour and the Vale and Shipston-on-Stour.

This area borders the historic town of Stratford-upon-Avon to the north and encompasses a large rural area with a variety of attractive villages and hamlets and the market town of Shipston-on-Stour to the south.

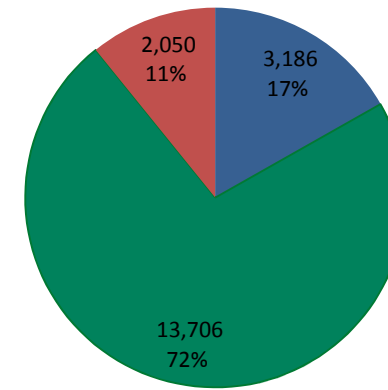

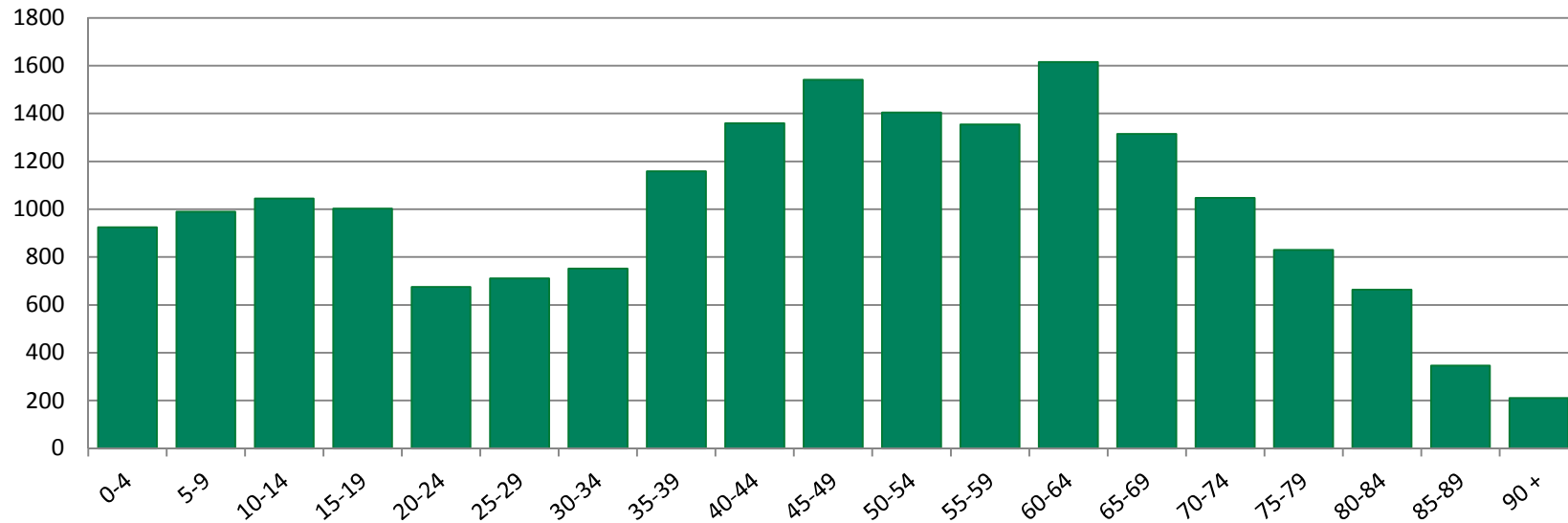

Population By Five Year Age Groups

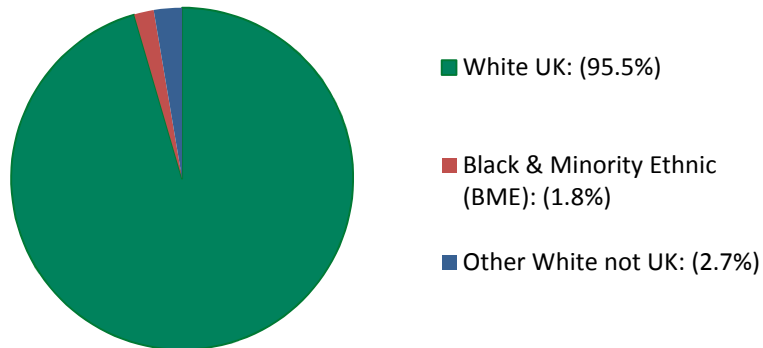

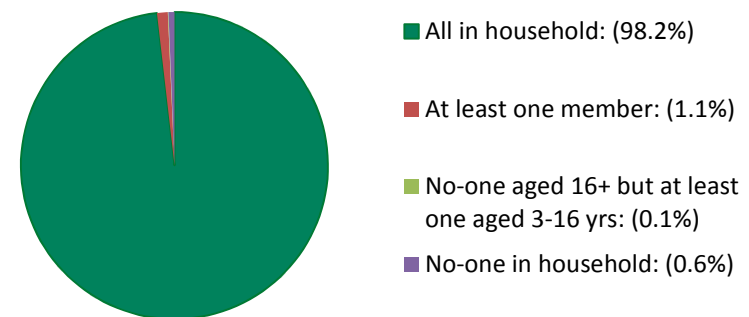

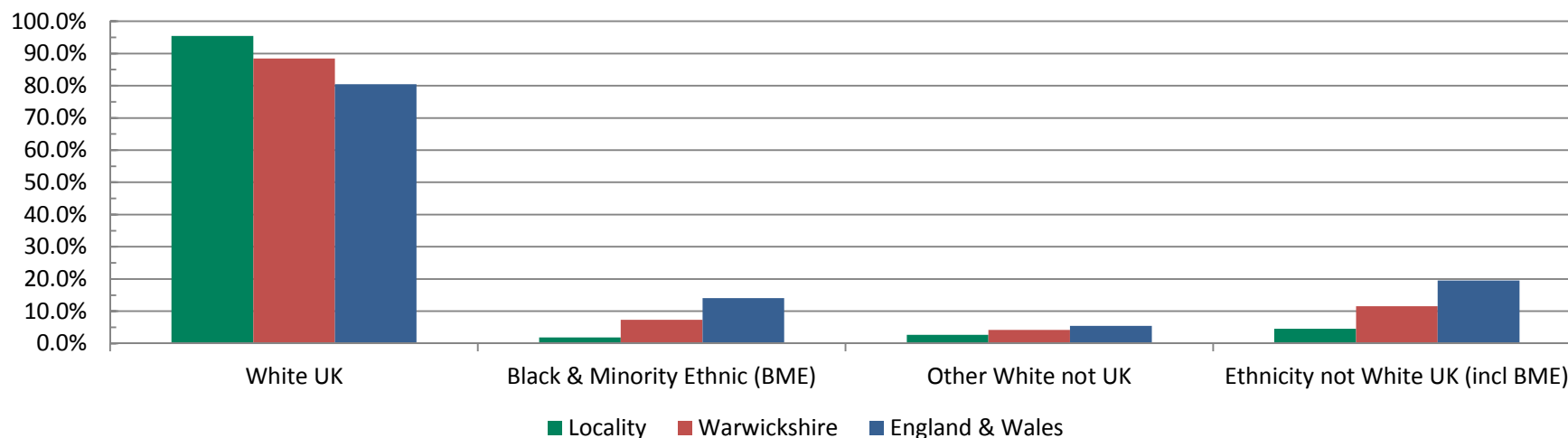
Composition of Locality Population

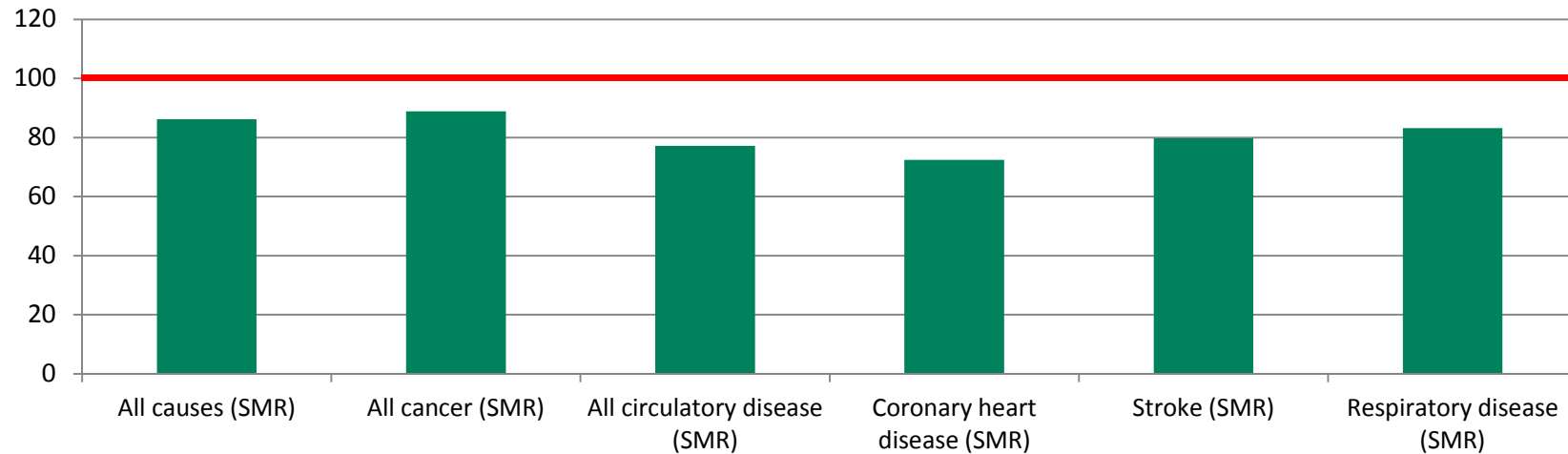

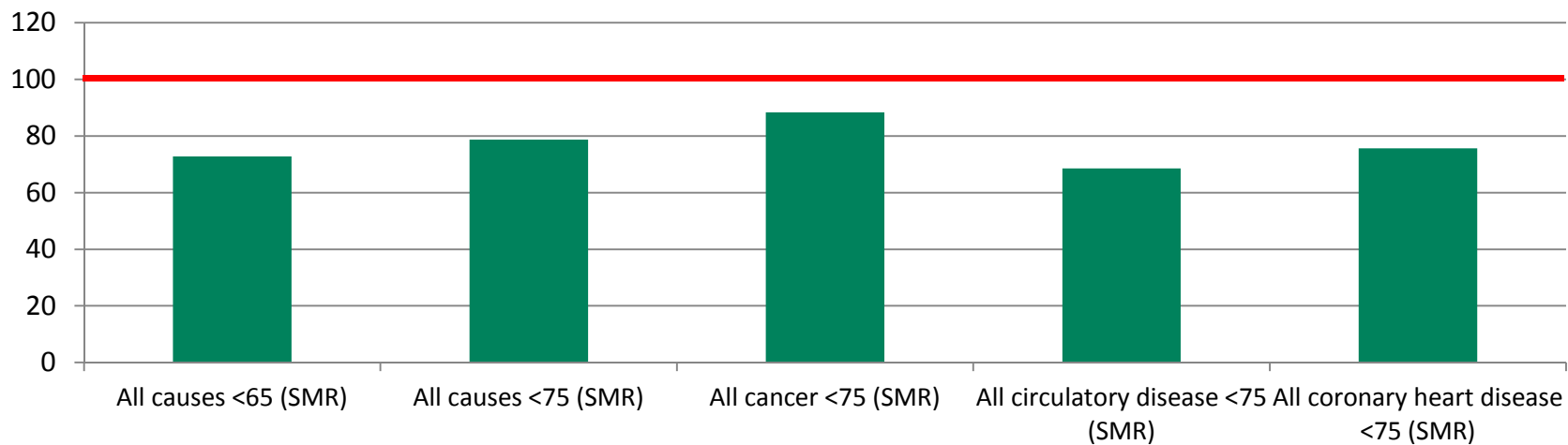

Due to the availability of the data, certain decisions were made that mean that the statistical geographies may differ slightly from administrative geographies.
