

South Leamington



The South Leamington locality comprises the wards & County Council Electoral Divisions of Willes & Brunswick. The Area is represented by 2 County Councillors, 6 District Councillors & 16 Town Councillors covering both North & South Leamington. The locality borders the railway station area & the River Leam to the North & stretches southwards up to the small residential town of Whitnash. It includes the ward areas Brunswick Ward known as the 'Old Town' area of South Leamington & Willes Ward that includes the Sydenham housing & industrial estate.

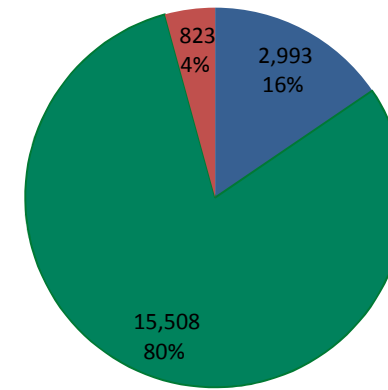

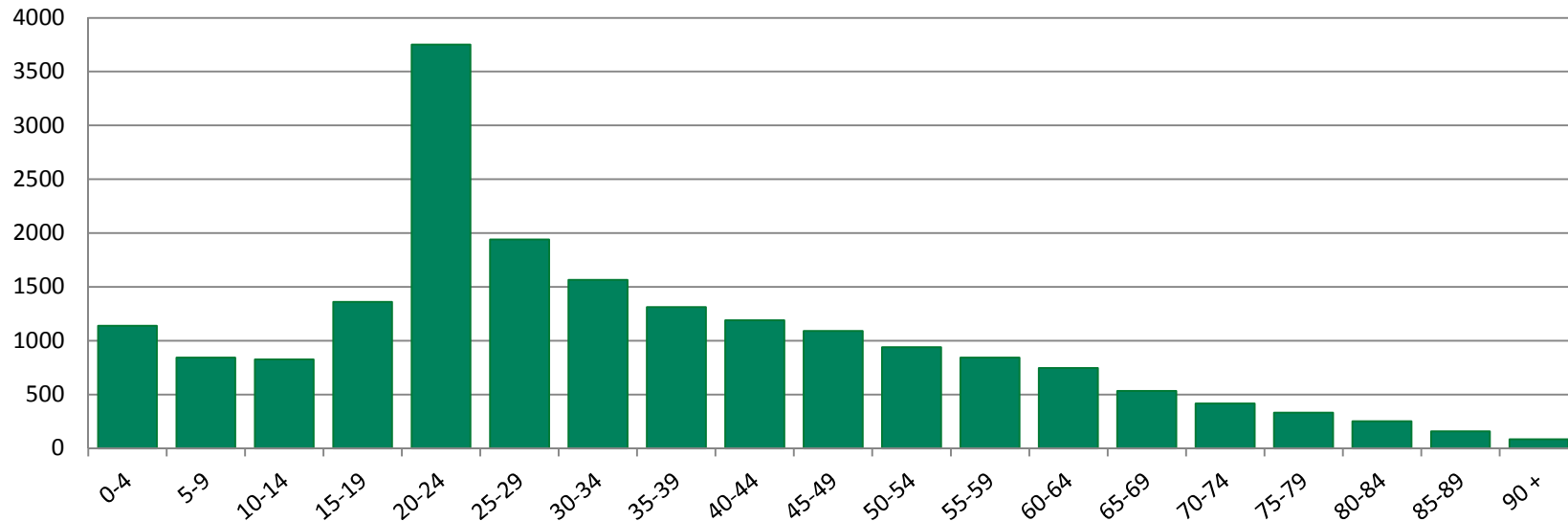

Population By Five Year Age Groups

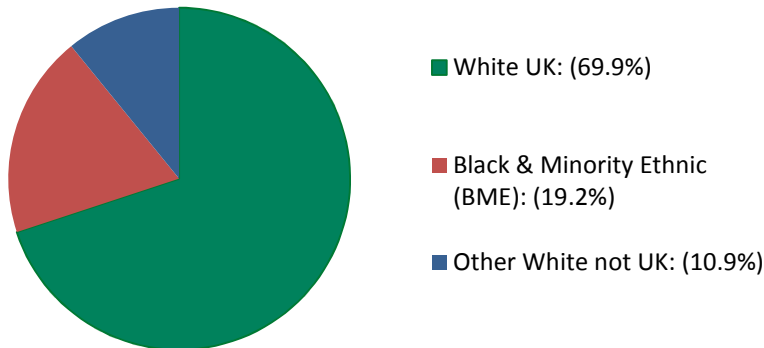

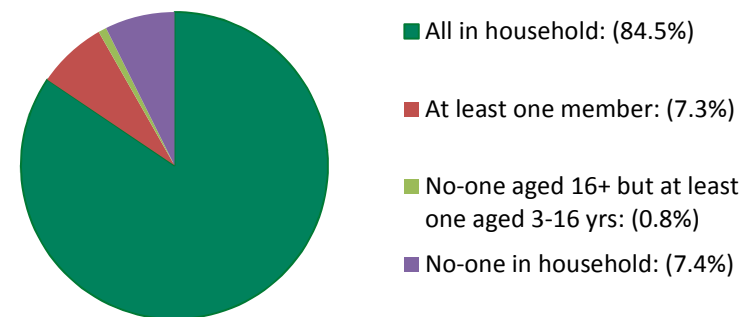

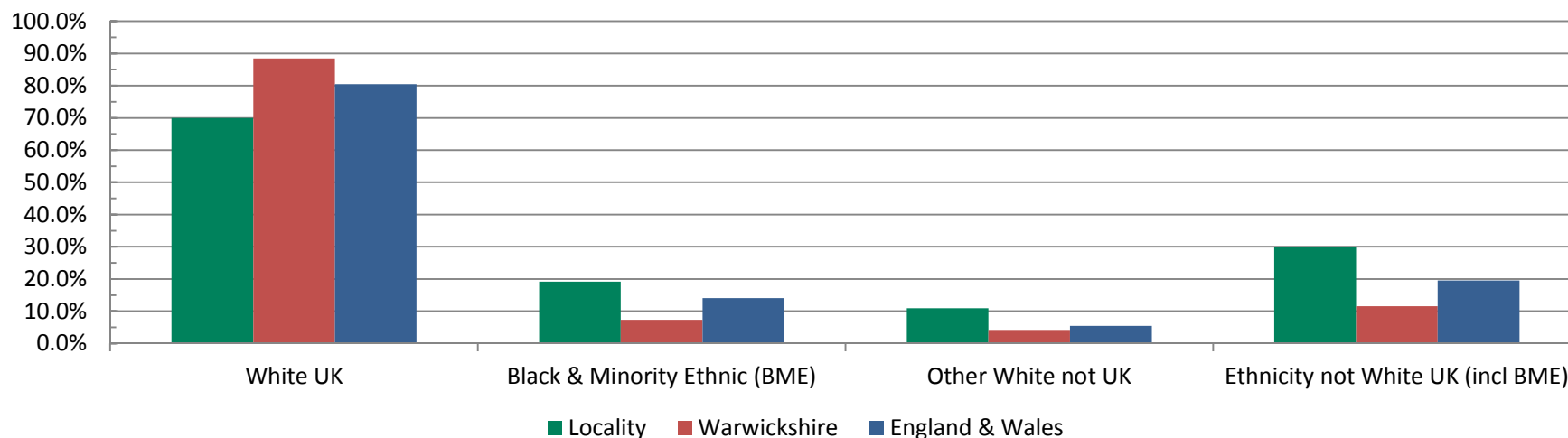
Composition of Locality Population

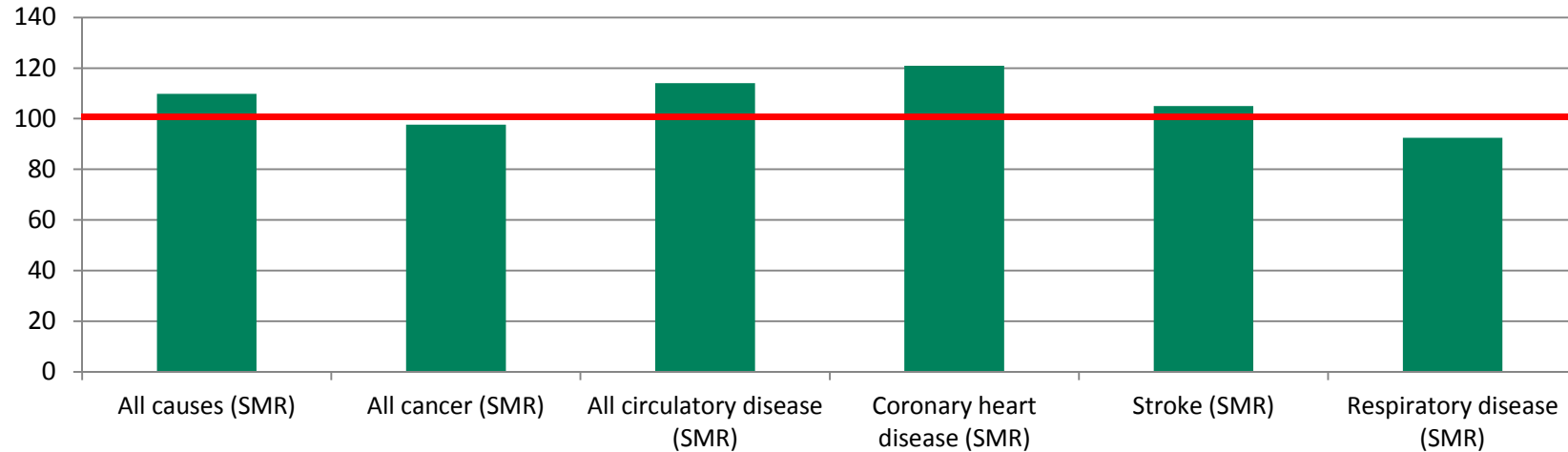

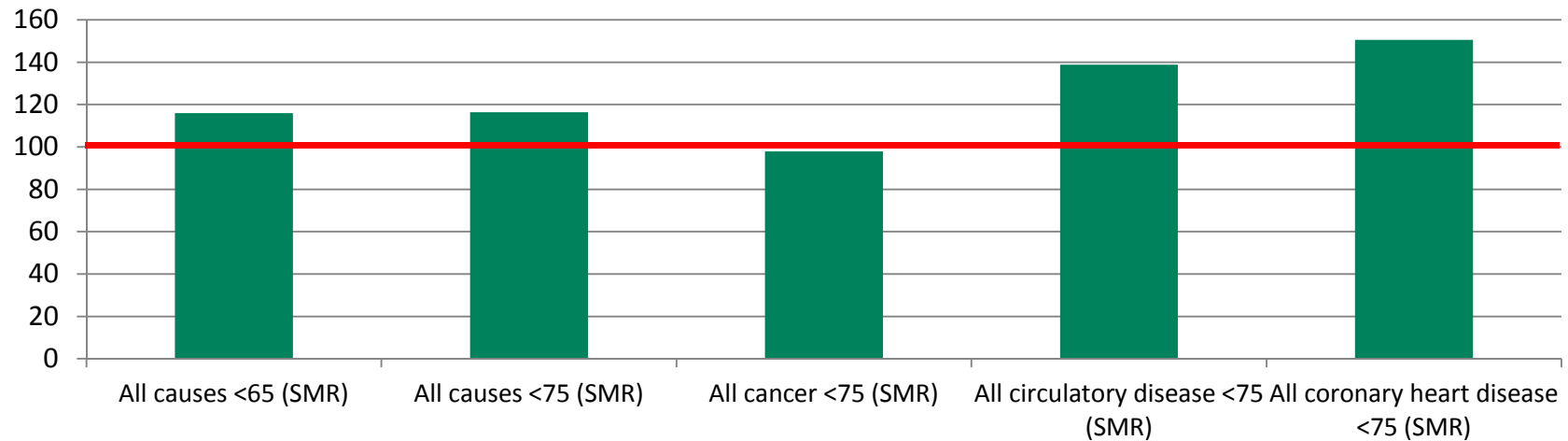
