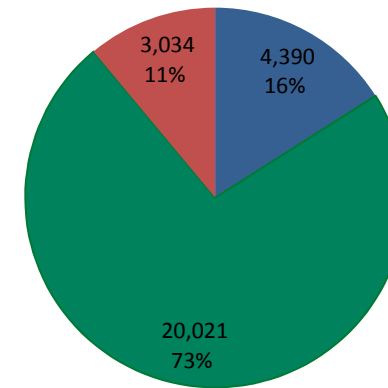

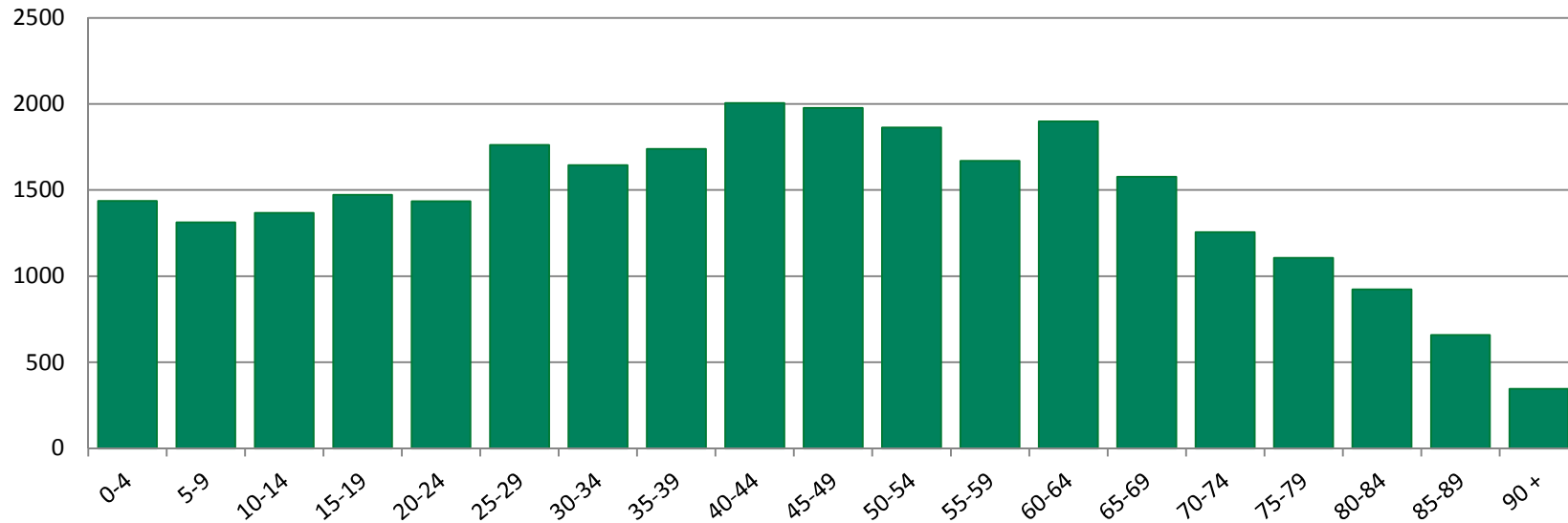

Population By Five Year Age Groups

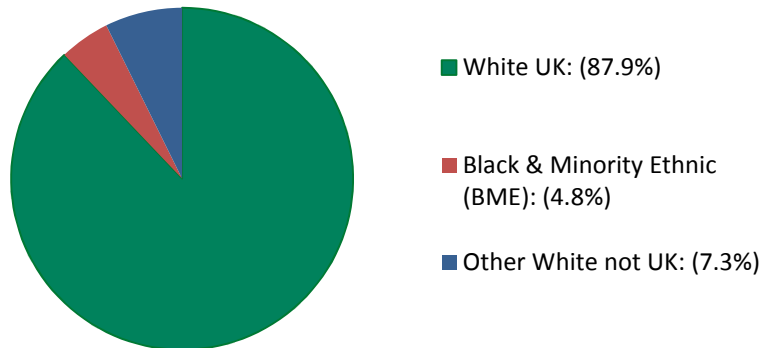

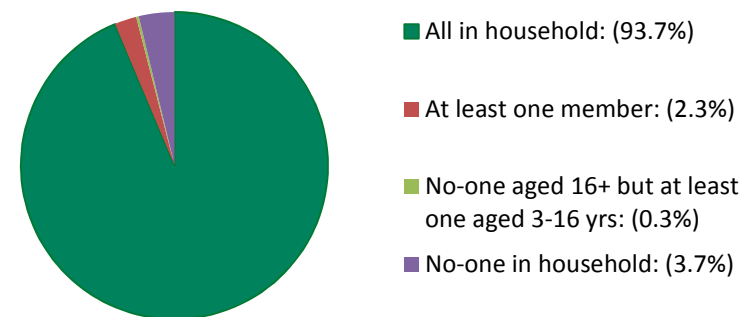

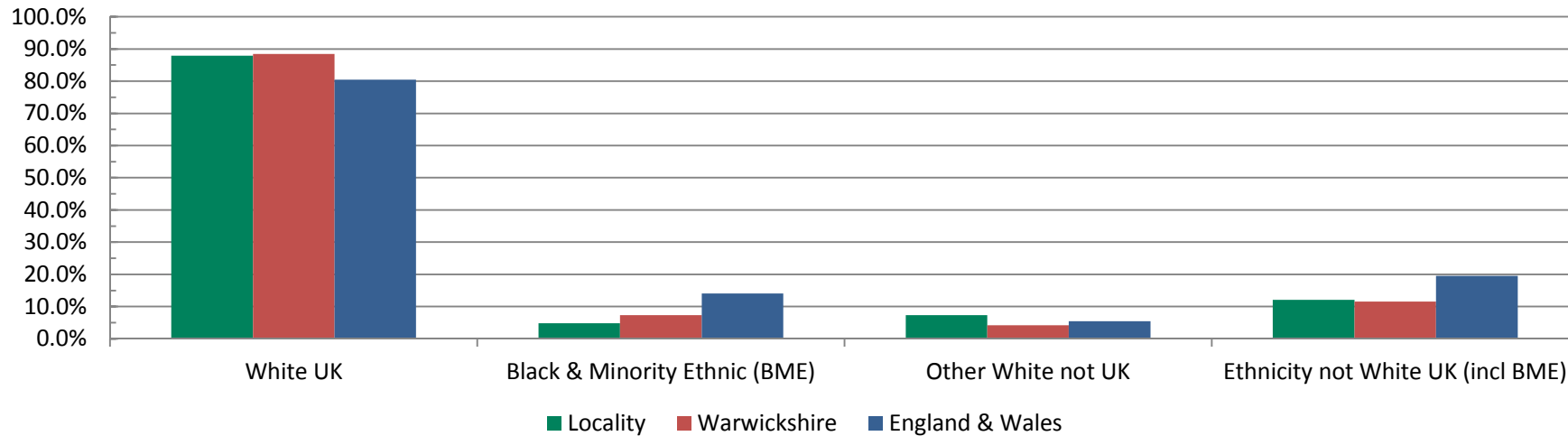
Composition of Locality Population

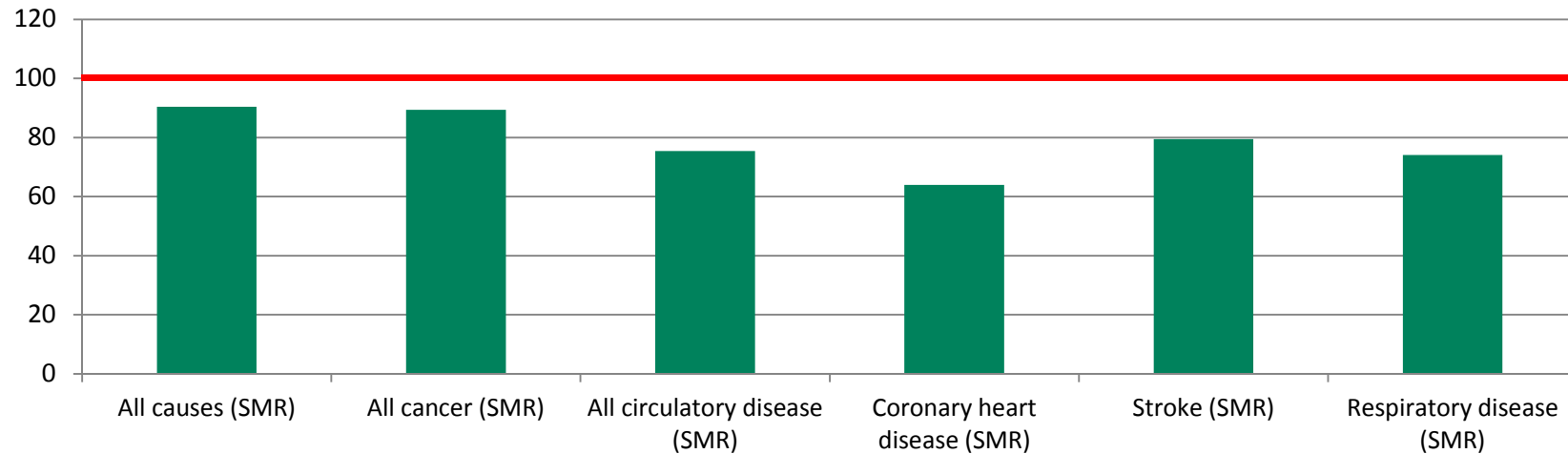

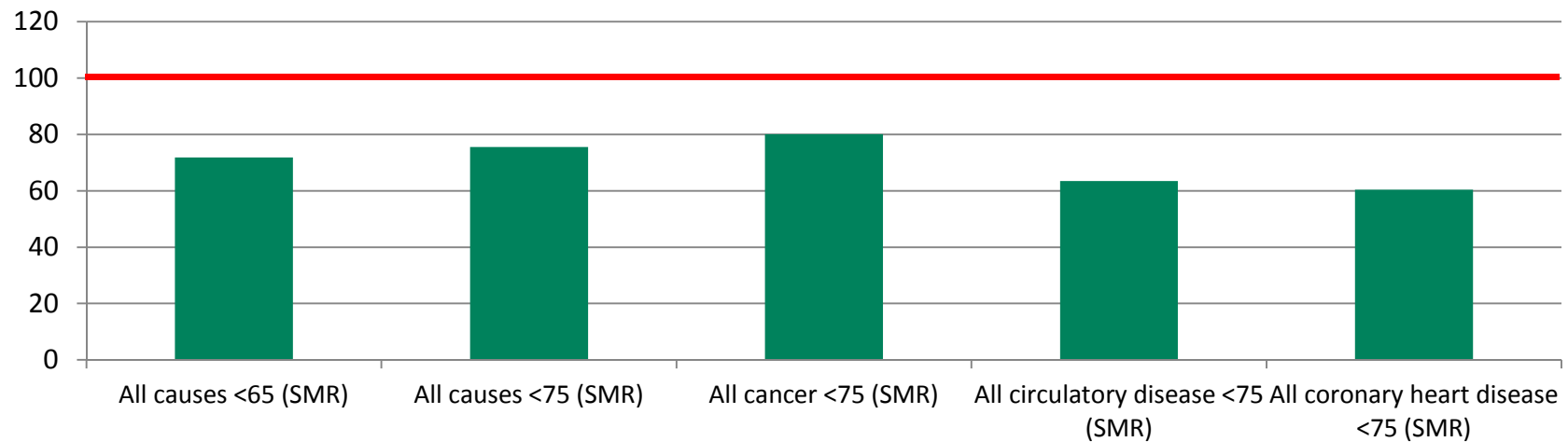
