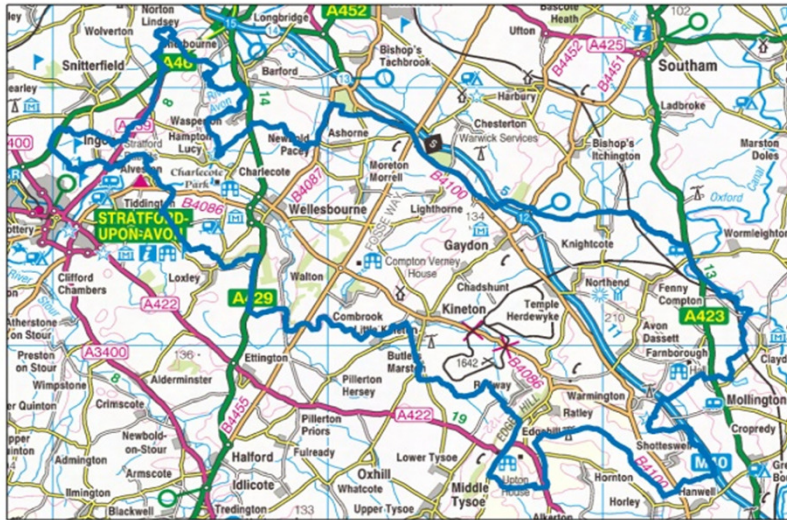


Wellesbourne & Kineton



The Wellesbourne and Kineton Locality comprises the wards of Wellesbourne, Kineton, Burton Dassett and part of Snitterfield and Fenny Compton. It includes the County Council Electoral Divisions of Wellesbourne, Kineton and a small area of Aston Cantlow. The area is essentially rural in nature with a mix of small towns, villages, hamlets and farms. It borders Stratford-upon-Avon to the west and Banbury in Oxfordshire to the south-east.

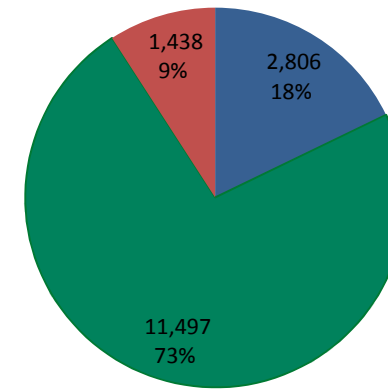

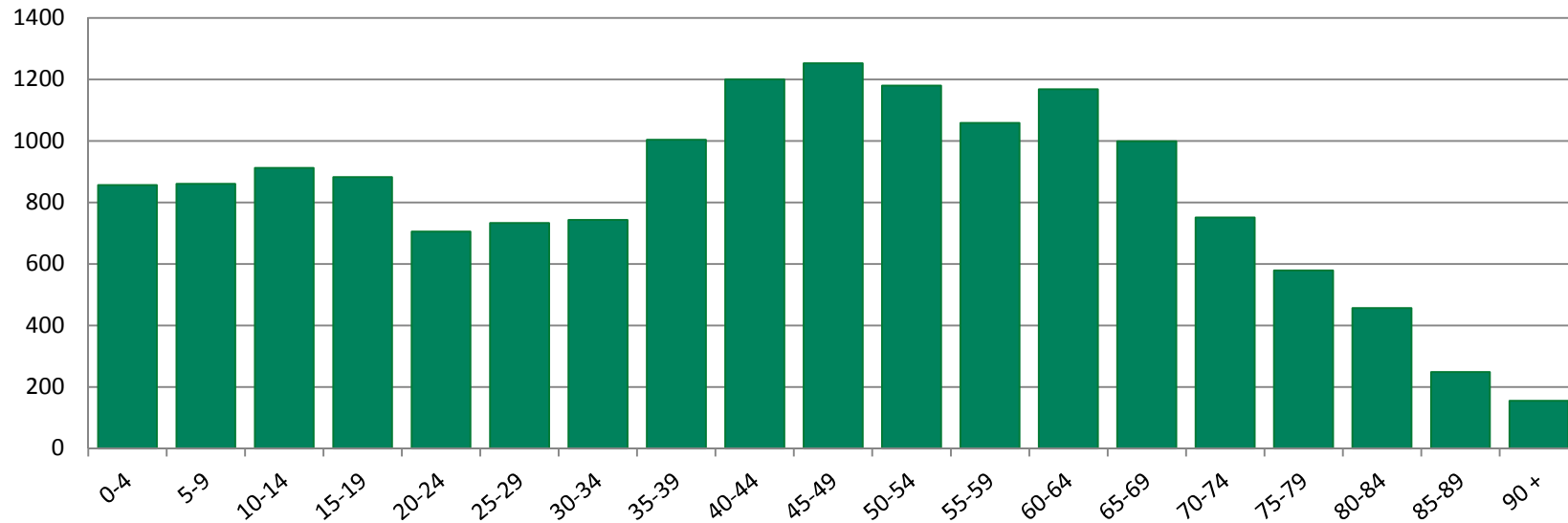

Population By Five Year Age Groups

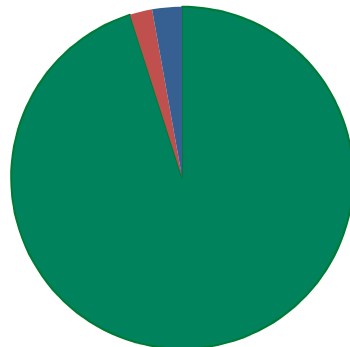

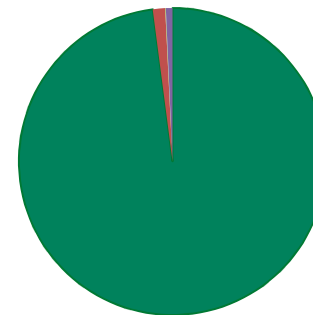

Composition of Locality Population



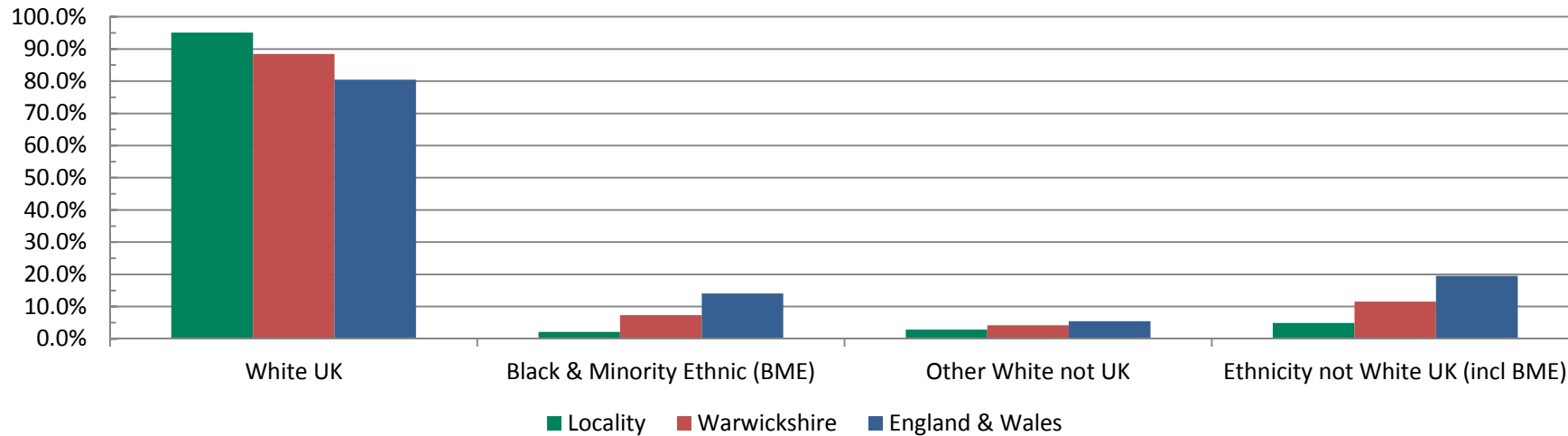

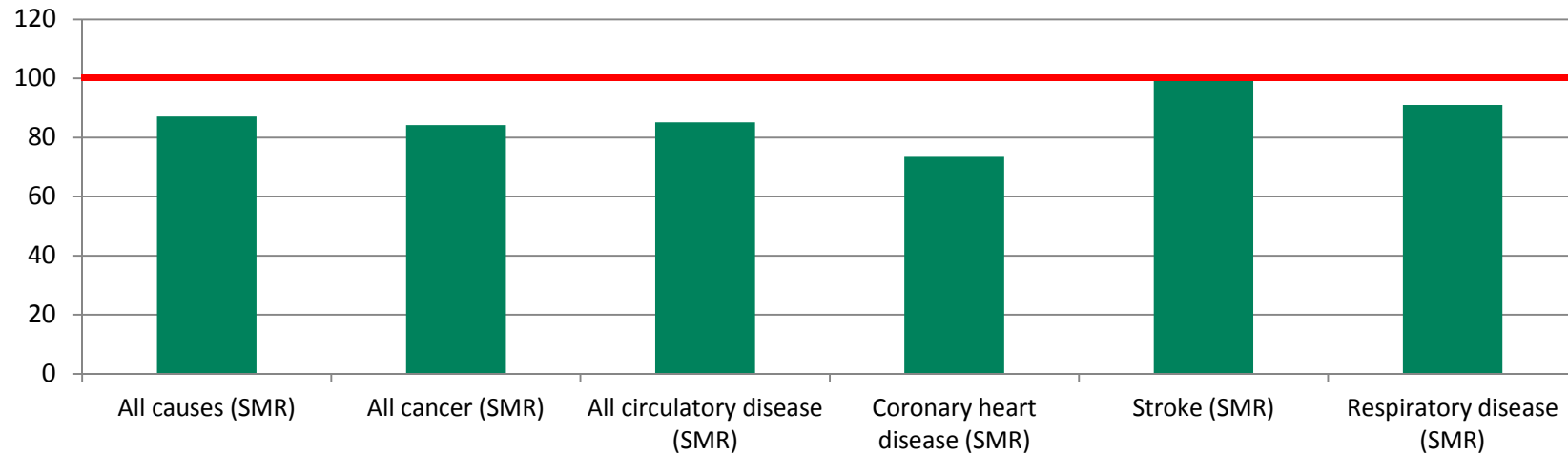

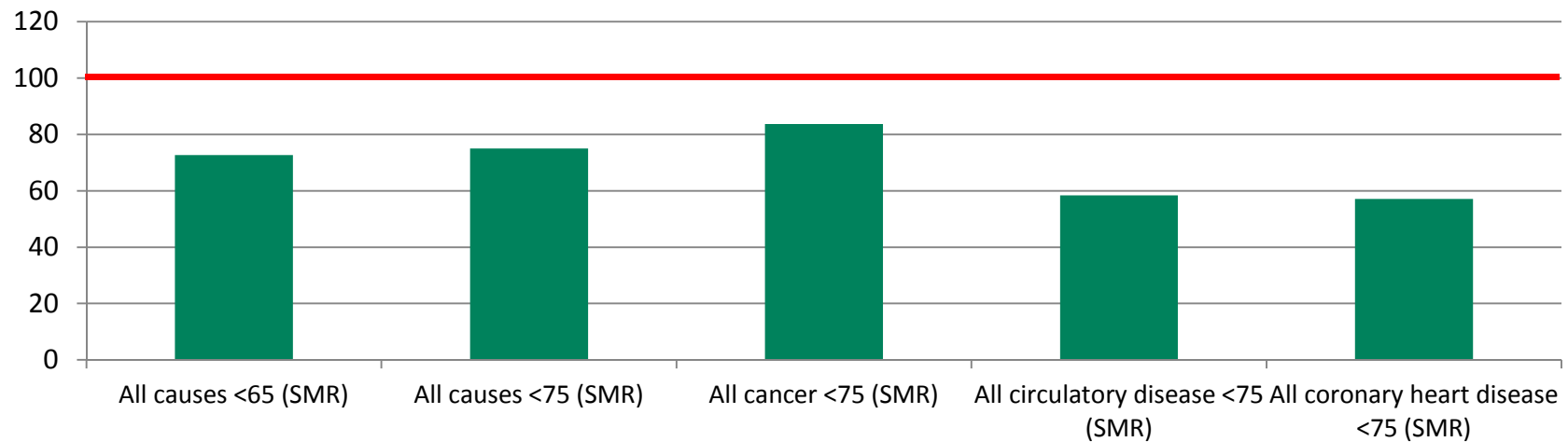
