


# Warwickshire County Council - Health & Wellbeing Locality Reports 2014

#### Whitestone & Bulkington



The locality of Whitestone and Bulkington comprises the same area as its namesake County Council Electoral Division and includes the wards of Bulkington, and the southernmost parts of Attleborough and Whitestone. This fairly rural locality is approximately 8 square miles in size with two distinct areas of settlement, the Whitestone area on the edge of Nuneaton in the north of the locality and the village of Bulkington to the south. The surrounding area contains a number of farms and isolated dwellings.




#### Mortality & causes of death - All Ages, 2006 to 2010
