198. Quality and Outcomes Framework 2015-16



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Summary

This publication provides data for the reporting year April 2015 to March 2016 and covers all General Practices in England which participated in the Quality and Outcomes Framework (QOF) in 2015-16. Participation by practices in the QOF is voluntary, though participation rates are very high at 96%, with most Personal Medical Services (PMS) practices also taking part.

There have been many changes to QOF coding and indicators. Consideration must be given to changes to indicators and their definitions each year when interpreting differences and comparing data from one year to the next.

Data is published at practice and CCG level, but can also be aggregated to County and District/Borough levels
