Summary

Public Health England released provisional data for the uptake of the seasonal influenza vaccine in GP registered patients, primary schools and for healthcare workers in England from 1 September to 30 November 2017.



The data is shown at Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) level for GP registered patients, primary schools and at national and individual trust level for healthcare workers.
